1 2 3 4 5 6 INTERMEDIATE

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

20 x 68 inches blocked

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Mohair super fine (fingering) weight mohair/silk yarn (7/8 oz/231 yds/25g per ball):
4 balls #147 iris
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



GAUGE

Before blocking: center of shell to center of next shell = 3¾ inches;
8 rows = 4¼ inches

After blocking: center of shell to center of next shell = 4¼ inches;
8 rows = 5 inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.



This 1954 chair set was the design inspiration for our gorgeous Purple Haze Wrap.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Shell: (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated ch sp.

Beginning shell (beg shell): (Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated sp.

WRAP

Row 1 (RS): Ch 66, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 sk chs count as first dc), dc in each rem ch across, turn. (64 dc)

Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 3 dc, [ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc] 19 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn. (19 ch-2 sps)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, **shell** (see Special Stitches)

in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-2 sps, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-2 sps, shell in next ch-2 sp**, [ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc] twice, rep from * to ** once, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn. (4 shells)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 4, sk next ch-5 sp, 6 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-5 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp**, dc

in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, rep from * to ** once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 5 times, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp**, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, rep from * to ** once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-3 sp, [(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp] 5 times, ch 2, sk next ch-3 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp**, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, rep from * to ** once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 5, sk next ch-2 sp, sk each of next 2 ch-1 sps, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-1 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp**, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, rep from * to ** once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Rows 8–111: [Rep rows 4–7 consecutively] 26 times.

Row 112: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, *ch 2, sk next ch-2

Our designer has transformed a pattern that was once a vintage chair set into an exquisite, light-as-air mohair wrap.



sp, sk first dc on next shell, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc of same shell, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, ch 2, sk first dc on next shell, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc of same shell**, [ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc] twice, rep from * to ** once, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 113: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, [2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc] 19 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

EDGING

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in first dc, *ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, sc in next dc*, rep from * to * across to last 3 dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, sc in beg ch-3, working

down side edge, **ch 2, sc in top of next row**, rep from ** to ** across to opposite side of foundation chain, ch 2, sc in ch at base of first st on Row 1, working across bottom edge, rep from * to * across, working up opposite side edge, rep from ** to ** across to first sc, ch 2, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first sc, turn.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 3, dc in same sc as beg ch-3, ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp, *sc in next ch-2 sp, shell in next ch-2 sp, rep from * across to next corner, ch 2**, 2 dc in next sc, ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, **do not turn**.

Rnd 3: Sl st in sp before next dc, **beg shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in same sp, *ch 1, shell in ch-2 sp of each shell across to next



corner, ch 1**, shell in sp between 2 dc in corner, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Carefully wash and block to finished measurements. **CW**
