## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

20 x 68 inches blocked

#### **MATERIALS**

• Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Mohair super fine (fingering) weight mohair/silk yarn (% oz/231 yds/ 25g per ball):



- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle


#### **GAUGE**

Before blocking: center of shell to center of next shell = 334 inches;  $8 \text{ rows} = 4\frac{1}{4} \text{ inches}$ 

After blocking: center of shell to center of next shell = 41/4 inches; 8 rows = 5 inches

# **PATTERN NOTES**

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.



This 1954 chair set was the design inspiration for our gorgeous Purple Haze Wrap.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

#### **SPECIAL STITCHES**

Shell: (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated ch sp.

Beginning shell (beg shell): (Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated sp.

# **WRAP**

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 66, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 sk chs count as first dc), dc in each rem ch across. turn. (64 dc)

Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 3 dc, [ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dcl 19 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn. (19 ch-2 sps)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, **shell** 

> (see Special Stitches) in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-2 sps. (dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-2 sps, shell in next ch-2 sp\*\*, [ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc] twice, rep from \* to \*\* once, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn. (4 shells)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 4, sk next ch-5 sp, 6 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-5 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, dc

in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, rep from \* to \*\* once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 5 times, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, rep from \* to \*\* once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc. \*ch 2. sk next ch-2 sp. shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-3 sp, [(dc, ch 1, dc)] in next ch-1 sp] 5 times, ch 2, sk next ch-3 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, rep from \* to \*\* once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 5, sk next ch-2 sp, sk each of next 2 ch-1 sps, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 5, sk each of next 2 ch-1 sps, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, rep from \* to \*\* once, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

**Rows 8–111:** [Rep rows 4–7 consecutively 26 times.

Row 112: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2







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sp, sk first dc on next shell, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc of same shell, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, ch 2, sk first dc on next shell, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc of same shell\*\*, [ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc] twice, rep from \* to \*\* once, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

Row 113: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, [2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc] 19 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in beg ch-3, turn.

# **EDGING**

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in first dc, \*ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, sc in next dc\*, rep from \* to \* across to last 3 dc, ch 2, sk each of next 2 dc, sc in beg ch-3, working

down side edge, \*\*ch 2, sc in top of next row\*\*, rep from \*\* to \*\* across to opposite side of foundation chain, ch 2, sc in ch at base of first st on Row 1, working across bottom edge, rep from \* to \* across, working up opposite side edge, rep from \*\* to \*\* across to first sc, ch 2, **join** (see Pattern Notes) in first sc, turn.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 3, dc in same sc as beg ch-3, ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp, \*sc in next ch-2 sp, shell in next ch-2 sp, rep from \* across to next corner, ch 2\*\*, 2 dc in next sc, ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp, rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, do not turn.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in sp before next dc, **beg shell** (see Special Stitches) in same sp, \*ch 1, shell in ch-2 sp of each shell across to next



corner, ch 1\*\*, shell in sp between 2 dc in corner, rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Carefully wash and block to finished measurements.
