# PURPLE MIST <br> KIMONO SWEATER 

# CROCHETED IN A LACY SPIDERWEB PATTERN WITH AN ATTACHED CROSSOVER FRONT, THIS FASHION-FRIENDLY SWEATER WORKS UP QUICKLY AND MAKES A GREAT LAYERING PIECE WHEN TEMPERATURES TURN CHILLY. 

## SKILL LEVEL intermeniate

FINISHED SIZES
Instructions given fit size small; changes for medium, large, X -large, 2 X -large and 3 X -large are in [ ].

## FINISHED GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Bust: $37 \frac{1}{4}$ inches (small) [401/2 inches (medium), 433/4inches (large), 47 inches ( $X$-large), $501 / 2$ inches ( $2 X$-large), $533 / 4$ inches ( $3 X$-large)]

## MATERIALS

- Berroco Ultra Alpaca Light light (DK) weight alpaca/
Peruvian wool yarn ( $13 / 4$
$0 z / 144 \mathrm{yds} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ per hank):
$4[4,5,5,6,6]$ hanks \#4283
lavender mix
- Size J/ $10 / 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

2 pattern reps $=41 / 2$ inches; 12 pattern rows $=5$ inches
Take time to check gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

Sweater is worked from side to side beginning at right sleeve, working right front and back at same time, splitting at neck and continuing left front and back at same time, ending with left sleeve.

Side and sleeve seams are assembled with cuffs, and skirting is added after assembly.
Chain-5 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet and chain-2 unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SWEATER

## Right Sleeve

Row 1: Ch 34 [34, 34, 42, 42, 42], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (33 [33, 33, 41, 41, 41] sc)

Row 2: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 3 sts , *ch 5 , sk next 3 sts**, sc in each of next 5 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in each of last 3 sts, turn.
Row 3: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 2 sts, *ch 3 , sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next st**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, [ch 3, sc in next ch- 3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in next st] across, turn.
Row 5: Ch 5 (see Pattern Notes), sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp, [ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp] across, ending with ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ in last st, turn.
Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, sk next st,
sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts] across, ch 3, sc in last st, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st] across to last ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in last ch-3 sp, sc in last st, turn.
Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts , *sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5 , sc in next ch-3 sp**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Rows 9-26: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively] 3 times.

Row 27: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, *ch 3 , sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next st**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in each of last 2 sts, ch 51 [51, 51, 61, 61, 61], drop Ip from hook, with another hank, join (see Pattern Notes) in first st of this row, ch 50 [ $50,50,60,60,60$ ], fasten off this hank, pick up dropped Ip, turn.

## Right Front \& Back

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 3, sk next 3 chs , sc in each of next 3 chs , ch 3, sk next 3 chs, [sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 chs, sc in each of next 3 chs, ch 3, sk next 3 chs] $4[4,4,5,5,5]$ times, sc in next st on Sleeve, *ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, rep from * across

Sleeve, [ch 3, sk next 3 chs, sc in each of next 3 chs, ch 3 , sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch] across, turn.
Rows 2-5: Rep rows 5-8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows 6-17 [6-17, 6-23, 6-23, 6-23, 6-29]: [Rep rows 3-8 of Right Sleeve consecutively] 2 [2, 3, 3, 3, 4] times.

Small \& X-Large Sizes Only
Rows 18-20 [24-26]: Rep rows 3-5 of Right Sleeve.

## Medium \& 2X-Large Sizes Only

Rows [18-22, 24-28]: Rep rows 3-7 of Right Sleeve.

## Large \& 3X-Large Sizes Only

Row [24, 30]: Rep row 3 of Right Sleeve.

## Back Neck

## Small \& X-Large Sizes Only

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts] 7 [8] times, ch 3 , sc in next ch-5 sp, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Rows 2 \& 3: Rep rows 7 and 8 of Right Sleeve.
Row 4: Rep row 3 of Right Sleeve.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in next st] across, ch 71 [81] for Left Front.

## Medium \& 2X-Large Sizes Only

Row [1]: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, *sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5 , sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * $[6,7]$ times, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5, sc in next
ch- 3 sp, sc in each of next 2 sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Rows [2-4]: Rep rows 3-5 of Right Sleeve.
Row [5]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts] across, ch 3, sc in last st, ch [77, 87] for Left Front.

## Large \& 3X-Large Sizes Only

Row [1]: Ch 1, sc in first st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in next st] [7, 8] times, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Rows [2-4]: Rep rows 5-7 of Right Sleeve.
Row [5]: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts , *sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5 , sc in next ch-3 sp**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in each of last 2 sts, ch [77, 87] for Left Front.

## Left Front \& Back

Small \& X-Large Sizes Only
Row 1: Sc in 8th ch from hook, sc in each of next 4 chs, ${ }^{* c h} 5$, sk next 3 chs**, sc in each of next 5 chs, rep from * across ch, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in next ch-3 sp on Back, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp, [ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp] across, ending with ch 2 , dc in last st, turn.
Rows 2-4: Rep rows 6-8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows 5-20 [5-26]: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively] 3 [4] times, ending last rep with row 6 . At end of last row, fasten off.

## Medium \& 2X-Large Sizes Only

Row [1]: Ch 1, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch, [ch 3, sk next 3 chs, sc in each of next 3 chs, ch 3 , sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch] [7, 8] times, sc in next st on Back Neck, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st] across to last ch- 3 sp, sc in last ch-3 sp, sc in last st, turn.

Row [2]: Rep row 8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows [3-20, 3-26]: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively of Right Sleeve] [3, 4] times.
Rows [21 \& 22, 27 \& 28]: Rep rows 3 and 4 of Right Sleeve. At end of last row, fasten off.

## Large \& 3X-Large Sizes Only

Row [1]: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, ch 3 , sk next 3 chs, [sc in each of next 3 chs, ch 3 , sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch, ch 3 , sk next 3 chs] $[7,8]$ times, sc in last ch, sc in each of next 2 sts on Back, *ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next st**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn.
Rows [2-6]: Rep rows 4-8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows [7-24, 7-30]: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively for Right Sleeve] [3, 4] times. At end of last row, fasten off.

## Left Sleeve

## Small \& X-Large Sizes Only

Row 1: Matching up with Right Sleeve, centered on last row of Left Front, join with sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, [ch 3, sc in next ch- 3 sp , sc in next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sk next st, sc in next st] across until same width as Right Sleeve, sc in next st of ch sp, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Row 2: Rep row 8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows 3-25: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively for Right Sleeve] 4 times, ending last rep with row 7.

Row 26: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, *3 sc in next ch-5 sp**, sc in each of next 5 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in each of last 3 sts, do not turn.

## Medium \& 2X-Large Sizes Only

Row [1]: Matching up with Right Sleeve, centered on last row of Left Front, join with sc in next st, ch 5 , sc in next ch- 3 sp , sc in each of next 3 sts , sc in next ch-3 sp, [ch 5 , sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp] across until same width as Right Sleeve, ch 2, dc in next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Rows [2-4]: Rep rows 6-8 of Right Sleeve.

Rows [5-25]: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively for Right Sleeve] 4 times, ending last rep with row 5 .
Row 26: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch-2 sp, [sc in each of next $5 \mathrm{sts}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch-5 sp] $[3,4]$ times, sc in each of next 5 sts , sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in last st, do not turn.

## Large \& 3X-Large Sizes Only

Match up with Right Sleeve, centered on last row of Left Front, join with sc in next st, sc in each of first 2 sts, *ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, sk next st**, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across until same width as Right Sleeve, sc in each of next 2 sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.
Rows [2-6]: Rep rows 4-8 of Right Sleeve.
Rows [7-24]: [Rep rows 3-8 consecutively of Right Sleeve] 3 times.
Row [26]: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, [3 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts] across, do not turn.

## Edging

Row 1: Working in ends of rows and in sts and ch sps, evenly sp sc around with 3 sc in corners, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## Assembly

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## Skirting

Rnd 1: Join with sc in center of left side seam, sc in same st, sc in each st across Back to right side seam, sc in each of next $4[6,8,10,12,4]$ sts, overlap and match rem sts on Right Front with corresponding sts on Left Front, working through both thicknesses, sc in each st around, join in beg sc.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each st around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, evenly sp $96[104,112,120$, 128, 136] sc around, join in beg sc.
Rnd 4: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 5 sts , ch 7, sk next 3 sts, [sc in each of next 5 sts, ch 7, sk next 3 sts] around, join in beg sc.
Rnd 5: Sl st in next st, ch 1 , sc in same st, sc in each of next 2 sts , ch 5 , sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 5, [sk next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 5 , sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 5] around, join in beg $s$.
Rnd 6: Sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st,
ch 5 , sc in next ch-5 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 5, [sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5 , sc in next ch-5 sp, sc in next st, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 5] around, join in beg sc.
Rnd 7: Ch 7, sk next st, (sc, \{ch 7, sc\} 3 times) in next st, ch 7, [sl st in next st, ch 7, sk next st, (sc, \{ch 7, sc\} 3 times) in next st, ch 7] around, join in joining st of last rnd. Fasten off.

## Cuff

Rnd 1: Join with sc in center of seam on Sleeve, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, sc in each st around, ending with Sc dec in last 2 sts , join in beg sc . ( $32[32,32$, $40,40,40]$ sc)

## All Sizes

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join in 3 rd ch of beg ch-3.
Rnd 3: Ch 1 , sc in each st around, join in beg sc.
Rnds 4-7: Rep rnds 4-7 of Skirting. Rep on rem Sleeve.

Single crochet decrease (sc dec): (Insert hook, yo, draw Ip through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

## Half double crochet

 decrease (hdc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Chain (ch): Yo, pull through Ip on hook.


Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.


Double crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.


## Double crochet

decrease (dc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw Ip through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back Ip) Front Loop Back Loop


Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of $s t$ on previous row.


## Half double crochet

 (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3

Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps ] 4 times.


Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.


Example of 2-tr dec

Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.


Chain color change (ch color change) Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.


Double crochet color change (dc color change) Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.


Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 $\mathrm{Ips}] 3$ times.


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
