



KALEIDOSCOPE DIAMONDS

DESIGN BY SUSAN JEFFERS

STITCHED IN SUPER FINE, ALPACA/SILK YARN, THIS LIGHT, LUXURIOUS SCARF PROVIDES JUST ENOUGH WARMTH ON A CHILLY SPRING EVENING.

SKILL LEVEL  INTERMEDIATE

FINISHED SIZE

13 x 64 inches

MATERIALS

- Classic Elite Yarns Silky Alpaca Lace super fine (fingering) weight alpaca/silk yarn (1¾ oz/440 yds/50g per ball):
 - 3 balls #2463 antique kaleidoscope
- Size E/4/3.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



GAUGE

Before blocking: 12 dc = 1 inch;
3 dc rows = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTES

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Cross-stitch (cross-st): Sk next 2 chs or sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, working around last 2 dc worked, dc in each of 2 sk sts.

Beginning cross-stitch (beg cross-st): Ch 3, dc in next st, dc in each of 2 previous sts.

SCARF

Row 1: Ch 90, dc in 4th ch from hook (*first 3 chs count as first dc*), **cross-st** (see *Special Stitches*), [dc in each of next 12 chs, cross-st] across, ending with dc in each of last 2 chs, turn. (6 cross-sts, 66 dc)

Row 2: **Ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in each of next 3 sts, [cross-st, dc in each of next 8 sts, cross-st] across, ending with dc in each of last 4 sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 5 sts, cross-st, [dc in each of next 4 sts, cross-st] across,

ending with dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each of next 7 sts, [cross-st twice, dc in each of next 8 sts] across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 9 sts, cross-st in next st, [dc in each of next 12 sts, cross-st] across, ending with dc in each of last 10 sts, turn.

Row 6: Rep row 5.

Row 7: Rep row 4.

Row 8: Rep row 3.

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in next st, cross-st, [dc in each of next 12 sts, cross-st] across, ending with dc in each of last 2 sts, turn.

Next rows: [Rep rows 2–9 consecutively] 18 times or to desired length, turn. **Do not fasten off.**

Edging

First End

First Diamond

Row 1: Sl st in each of first 7 sts, **beg cross-st** (see *Special Stitches*), dc in each of next 8 sts, cross-st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.

Row 2: Sl st in each of first 5 sts, beg cross-st, dc in each of next 4 sts, cross-st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each of first 5 sts, beg cross-st, cross-st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.

Row 4: Sl st in each of first 5 sts, beg cross-st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. Fasten off.

2nd Diamond

Row 1: Sk next 2 sts on last row of Scarf, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in next st, beg cross-st, dc in each of next 8 sts, cross-st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.

Rows 2–4: Rep rows 2–4 of First Diamond.

3rd–5th Diamonds

Rep 2nd Diamond.

2nd End

First Diamond

Row 1: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Scarf, sk first 6 chs, join in next ch, beg cross-st, dc in each of next 8 chs, cross-st, leaving rem chs unworked, turn.

Rows 2–4: Rep rows 2–4 of First Diamond of First End.

2nd Diamond

Row 1: Sk next 2 chs on starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Scarf, join in next ch, beg cross-st, dc in each of next 8 chs, cross-st, leaving rem chs unworked, turn.


Rows 2–4: Rep rows 2–4 of First Diamond of First End.

3rd–5th Diamonds

Rep 2nd Diamond of 2nd End.

Finishing

Steam-block to shape, slightly stretching to show Diamond detail. Block each point. **C!**



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
