
# **Sweetheart Jacket**

#### **SKILL LEVEL**



#### **FINISHED SIZE**

Instructions given fit infant's size 6 to 12 months.

#### **MATERIALS**

 Bernat Softee Baby light (light worsted) weight acrylic yarn (5 oz/ 362 yds/140g per ball):



1 ball each #02000 white, #02001 pink, #02002 pale blue, #02004 mint and #30185 soft lilac

- Sizes E/4/3.5mm and G/6/4mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- · Sewing needle
- ½-inch pink buttons: 4
- · Pink sewing thread

# **GAUGE**

Size G hook: 5 sc = 1 inch

# **PATTERN NOTES**

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-1 at beginning of double crochet row is not counted as a stitch.

# **JACKET**

# **RIGHT FRONT**

**Row 1 (RS):** Starting at bottom with size G hook and white, ch 24, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (23 sc)

**Row 2: Ch 1** (see Pattern Notes), dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn. (23 dc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in first st, [**fpdc** (see Stitch Guide) around next st, dc in next st] across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, dc in first st, [**bpdc** (see Stitch Guide) around next st, dc in next st] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: Join (see Pattern Notes) lilac in first st, ch 1, dc in same st and in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 6:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in same st and in each st across, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 9: With blue, rep row 5.

**Rows 10–12:** Rep rows 6–8.

Row 13: With pink, rep row 5.

**Rows 14–16:** Rep rows 6–8.

Row 17: For neck shaping, join mint in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off. (22 dc)

**Row 18:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. (21 dc)

**Row 19:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. (20 dc)

**Row 20:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off. (19 dc)

**Row 21:** Join lilac in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off. (18 dc)

**Row 22:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. (17 dc)

Row 23: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc

dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. (16 dc)

Row 24: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

Row 25: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across. Fasten off.

## **LEFT FRONT**

**Rows 1–16:** Rep rows 1–16 of Right Front.

**Row 17:** Join mint in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off.  $(22 \ dc)$ 

**Row 18:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. (21 dc)

**Row 19:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. (20 dc)

**Row 20:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off. (19 dc)

**Row 21:** Join lilac in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off.  $(18 \ dc)$ 

**Row 22:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn. (17 dc)

**Row 23:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. (16 dc)

**Rows 24 & 25:** Rep rows 24 and 25 of Right Front.

# **BACK**

**Row 1:** With white, ch 51, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (50 sc)





Row 2: Ch 1, dc in first st, sc in each rem ch across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in first st, fpdc around next st, [dc in next st, fpdc around next st] across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, bpdc around first st, dc in next st, [bpdc around next st, dc in next st] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: Join lilac in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 6:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 9:** With blue, rep row 5.

**Rows 10–12:** Rep rows 6–8.

**Row 13:** With pink, rep row 5.

**Rows 14–16:** Rep rows 6–8.

**Row 17:** With mint, rep row 5.

**Rows 18–20:** Rep rows 6–8.

**Rows 21 & 22:** Rep rows 5 and 6.

# **First Shoulder**

**Row 23:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each of next 15 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (18 dc)

**Row 24:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next st, dc in each rem st across, turn. (17 dc)

**Row 25:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st. Fasten off. (16 dc)

# **2nd Shoulder**

**Row 23:** Sk next 12 sts on last row of Back, join white in next st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each rem st across, turn.  $(18 \ dc)$ 

**Row 24:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across to last 3 sts, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. (17 dc)

**Row 25:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc dec in next st, dc in each rem st across. Fasten off. (16 dc)

# **SLEEVE**

Make 2.

**Row 1:** Starting at cuff, with

size G hook and white, ch 28, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (27 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn. (27 dc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in first st, [fpdc around next st, dc in next st] across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, dc in first st, [bpdc around next st, dc in next st] across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 5:** Join lilac in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 6:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, 2 dc in next st, dc in each rem st across to last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn. (29 dc)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 9:** Join blue in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 10:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, 2 dc in next

st, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn. (31 dc)

**Row 11:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, dc in same st, 2 dc in next st, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off. (33 dc)

**Row 13:** Join pink in first st, ch 1, dc in same st and in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Rows 14–16:** Rep rows 10–12. (37 dc)

**Row 17:** Join mint in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 18:** Join white in first st, ch 1, dc in same st, dc in each rem st across, turn.

**Row 19:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each rem st across. Fasten off. Sew shoulder seams. Matching last row of Sleeves to shoulder

seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

#### **EDGING**

**Row 1:** With size G hook and white, join with sc at bottom corner of Right Front, evenly sp 111 sc around neck edge to bottom left corner, turn. (112 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 49 sts, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 10 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 22 sts, [ch 2, sk next 2 sts, sc in each of next 5 sts (buttonhole)] 3 times, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, sc in each of last 4 sts, turn. (102 sc, 4 buttonholes)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sts, [2 sc in next ch sp, sc in each of next 5 sts] 3 times, 2 sc in next ch sp, sc in each of next 22 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of last 49 sts. Fasten off.

#### **HEART**

## Make 2.

**Row 1:** With E hook and pink, ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, turn. (2 sc)


**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st across, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rnd 4: Now working in rnds, ch 2, hdc in same st, (dc, hdc, sl st) in next st, (sl st, ch 2, hdc) in next st, (dc, hdc, sl st) in last st, sl st in end of each of next 2 rows, working in opposite side of foundation ch of row 1, sl st in first ch, ch 1, sl st in next ch, sl st in end of each of next 2 rows. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Left Front opposite buttonholes.

Tack Hearts to each side of Jacket on Front.



## Single crochet decrease (sc dec):


(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

#### Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):

(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.


Reverse single crochet (reverse sc): Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo, and draw through both lps on hook.




Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.




Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



Double crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps]




**Double crochet** decrease (dc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.




# Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)




Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.




Half double crochet (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



**Double treble** crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.




Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.




Chain color change (ch color change)

Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



**Double crochet** color change (dc color change)

Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



Treble crochet (tr):

Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
