

# Teddy Bear Block Blanket

## SKILL LEVEL

■ ■ ■ ■ □ INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZE

42 x 36 inches

## MATERIALS

- Caron One Pound medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (16 oz/812 yds/453g per skein):
  - 1 skein each #589 cream (A) and #571 nutmeg (B)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle



## GAUGE

3 sc = 1 inch; 3 sc rows = 1 inch;  
Panel width = 8¼ inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Each square of chart equals 1 single crochet worked in indicated color. Read odd-numbered rows right to left and even-numbered rows left to right.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**V-stitch (V-st):** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

**Shell:** (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in indicated st.

## BLANKET

### PANEL 1

#### Make 2.

#### Teddy Bear Block

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, ch 26, sc in

2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (25 sc)

**Rows 2–27:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, **change color** (see *Stitch Guide*) as indicated (see *Chart*), work over color not in use, turn. At the end of row 24, fasten off B. At the end of row 27, **do not fasten off**.

#### Lace Block

**Row 28:** Continuing with A, ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (25 sc)

**Row 29: Ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), **[V-st** (see *Special Stitches*) in next st, sk next 3 sts, **shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next st, sk next 2 sts] 3 times, V-st in next st, sk next st, dc in last st, turn. (7 ch-1 sps)

**Row 30:** Ch 3, [shell in next ch-1 sp of V-st, V-st in next ch-1

sp of shell] 3 times, shell in next ch-1 sp of V-st, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn.

**Row 31:** Ch 3, [V-st in next ch-1 sp of shell, shell in next ch-1 sp of V-st] 3 times, V-st in next ch-1 sp of shell, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn.

**Rows 32–39:** [Rep rows 30 and 31 alternately] 4 times.

**Row 40:** Rep row 30.

**Row 41:** Ch 1, [sc in each of next 3 dc, sk next ch-1 sp] 3 times, sc in each of next 3 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, [sc in each of next 3 dc, sk next ch-1 sp] 3 times, sc in each of next 3 dc, turn. (25 sc)

**Row 42:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 43–82:** Rep rows 2–41. At the end of row 82, **do not turn**.





*Alternating lace and solid-stitch teddy bear patterns look like individual blocks but are actually worked as continuous panels.*

<b>bpsc</b> .....	back post single crochet

<b>ch-</b> .....	refers to chain or space previously made (i.e., ch-1 space)

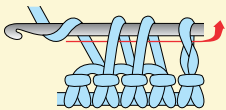

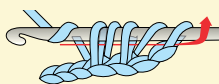
sl st (slip stitch)	=	sc (single crochet)
sc (single crochet)	=	dc (double crochet)
hdc (half double crochet)	=	htr (half treble crochet)
dc (double crochet)	=	tr (treble crochet)
tr (treble crochet)	=	dtr (double treble crochet)
dtr (double treble crochet)	=	ttr (triple treble crochet)
skip	=	miss

**Single crochet decrease (sc dec):**  
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



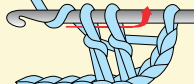
Example of 2-sc dec

**Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):**  
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



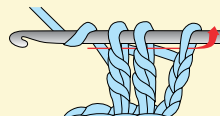
Example of 2-hdc dec

**Double crochet decrease (dc dec):** (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



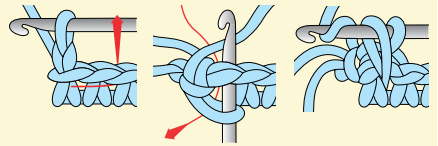
Example of 2-dc dec

**Treble crochet decrease (tr dec):** Hold back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

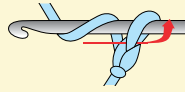


Example of 2-tr dec

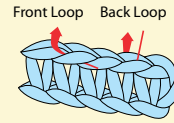
**Reverse single crochet (reverse sc):** Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo, and draw through both lps on hook.



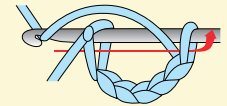
**Chain (ch):** Yo, pull through lp on hook.



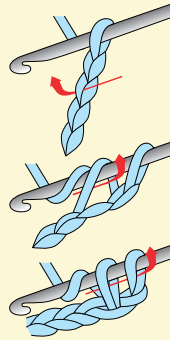
**Front loop (front lp)  
Back loop (back lp)**



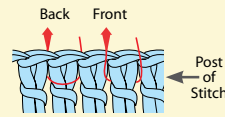
**Slip stitch (sl st):** Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



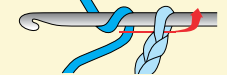
**Single crochet (sc):** Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



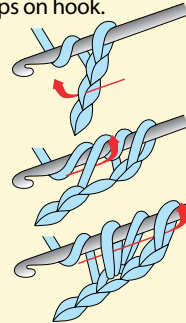
**Front post stitch (fp):  
Back post stitch (bp):** When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



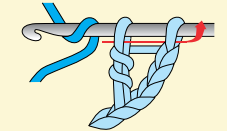
**Chain color change (ch color change)**  
Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



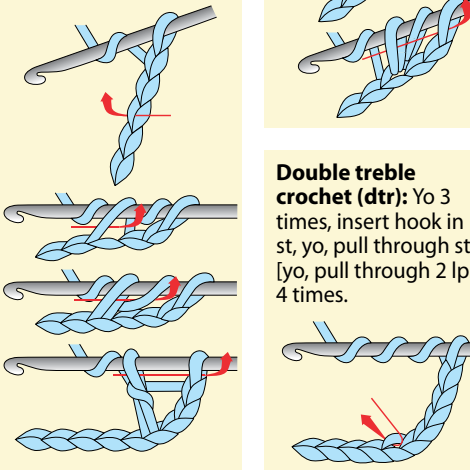
**Half double crochet (hdc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



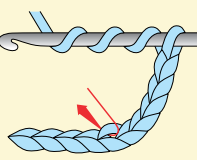
**Double crochet color change (dc color change)**  
Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



**Double crochet (dc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



**Double treble crochet (dtr):** Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



**Treble crochet (tr):** Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
