Cabled Boot Toppers

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

7½ inches tall x 13 inches in circumference

Folded over top of boot: 4 inches tall, excluding fringe

MATERIALS

• Plymouth Yarn Encore
Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool
yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/
100g per ball):
2 balls #6007

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- 2 balls #6007 light grey heather
- Size 7/4.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle

GAUGE

6 dc post sts = $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches; 7 sc = 2 inches; 7 sc rows = $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCH

4-double crochet cluster (4-dc cl): [Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo, draw up lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 4 times in same st, yo, draw through all 5 lps on hook.

BOOT TOPPER

INNER SECTION

Make 2.

Row 1 (WS): Loosely ch 58, dc



in 4th ch from hook (3 sk chs count as first dc), dc in each ch across, turn. (56 dc)

Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), [fpdc (see Stitch Guide) around post of next dc, bpdc (see Stitch Guide) around post of next dc] rep across, ending with dc in last st, turn. (27 fpdc, 27 bpdc, 2 dc)

Rows 3–10: Ch 3, fpdc around each fpdc, bpdc around each bpdc, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. (56 sc)

Row 12: Rep row 11.

Row 13 (WS): Ch 1, working in front lp (see Stitch

Guide) of each st, sc in each st across, turn.

CABLE SECTION

Rows 14 & 15: Rep row 11.

Row 16: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sts, *working around sts of row 13, sk next 4 sc, fpdc around each of next 2 sc of row 13 (5th and 6th sc sts), working in front of fpdc just made, fpdc around each of 2 sk sc of row 13 (3rd and 4th sc sts)**, sc in each of next 4 sc of row 15, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (28 fpdc, 28 sc)

Row 17 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, *fpdc around each of next 4 fpdc, sc in each of next 2 sc**, **4-dc cl** (see Special Stitch) in next sc, sc in next sc, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, turn. (28 fpdc, 22 sc, 6 4-dc cls)

Row 19: Rep row 17.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, *sk first 2 fpdc, fpdc around next 2 fpdc (3rd and 4th fpdc sts), working in front of fpdc sts, fpdc around 2 sk fpdc sts (first and 2nd fpdc sts)**, sc in each of next 4 sts (2 sc, 4-dc cl and sc), rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 21: Rep row 19.

Row 22: Rep row 18.

Row 23: Rep row 19.

Row 24: Rep row 20.

Row 25: Rep row 19.

Row 26: Rep row 18.

Row 27: Rep row 19.

Row 28: Rep row 20.


Rows 29 & 30: Rep row 19. At the end of row 30, fasten off.

FINISHING

Cut 112 lengths each 2½ inches long.

*Holding 2 strands tog, fold in half, insert hook in next sc of row 30, draw strands through at fold to form a lp on hook, draw cut ends through lp on hook, pull ends gently to secure, rep from * in each sc of row 30.

Thread tapestry needle with a length of yarn, **whipstitch** (see illustration) edges tog.



Whipstitch Edges

Fold rows 1–13 of Inner Section to inside of Cable Section. ■






(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.




Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.




Single crochet (sc):

Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.




Double crochet (dc):




Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp):

When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.





(hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.








Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.




Chain color change (ch color change)
