MATERIALS

 Berroco Comfort medium (worsted) weight yarn (3½ oz/210 yds/100g per ball):



16 balls #9761 lovage

- Sizes H/8/5mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Size I hook: 31 sts = 10 inches; 33 pattern rows = 9 inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Leave stitch behind post stitch unworked.

All post stitches are worked around post of stitch 2 rows below.

Push chain-3 loops to right side of work as work progresses to create bobble.

Pattern is established in rows 8–15.

Pattern is worked in multiples of 62 plus 10 chains.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Front post treble cross (fptr cross): Sk next st, fptr around next st, with hook in front of post st just made, fptr around st just sk.

Crooked front post double treble cross (crooked fpdtr cross): Sk first post st in post st cross 2 rows below fodtr around

cross 2 rows below, fpdtr around next post st, with hook in front, fpdtr around sk post st.

Front post double treble

cross (fpdtr cross): Sk next 2 sts, fpdtr around next st, sc in next st on this row, with hook in front, fpdtr around first sk st.

Back post double treble cross (bpdtr cross): Sk next 2 sts, fpdtr around next st, sc in next st on this row, with hook in back, fpdtr around first sk st.

Front post treble treble cross (fptrtr cross): Sk next 3 sts, fptrtr around next st, sc in each of next 2 sts on this row, with hook in front, fptrtr around first sk st.

Closing single crochet (closing sc): Insert hook in **back lp** *(see Stitch Guide)* of sk st 2 rows below, then insert hook in st 1 row below this row, yo, pull lp through sts, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

Front post treble treble/front post treble split (fptrtr/fptr split): Yo 4 times, insert hook around post of st 3 sts to right, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] 4 times, yo twice, insert hook around post of st 1 st to right, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

Front post treble/front post treble treble split (fptr/fptrtr split): Yo twice, insert hook around post of st 1 st to left, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo 4 times, insert hook around post of st 3 sts to left, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] 4 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

PONCHO

FRONT

Row 1 (RS): With size I hook, ch 134, sc in **back bar** (see *illustration*) of 2nd ch from hook, sc in back bar of each ch across, turn. (133 sc)



Back Bar of Chain

Rows 2–4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 9 sts, *ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in each of next 14 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 8 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 14 sts, ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in each of next 10 sts, rep from * across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 16 sts] twice, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 12 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 16 sts] twice, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 10 sts, twice, ch 3, sc in each of last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, fptr cross (see Special Stitches), sc in next st, [sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross (see Special Stitches), sc in next st, fptrtr cross (see Special Stitches), sc in next st, fpdtr cross] twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, fptr (see Stitch Guide) around each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, [sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross] twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts] twice, fptr cross, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, **closing sc** (see Special Stitches) twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 20 sts] twice, ch 3, sc in each of next 7 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 7 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 7 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 5 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sts, crooked fpdtr cross (see Special Stitches), sc in each of next 3 sts, \$\$ ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in next st*, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptr, sc in each of next 2 sts, fptr, sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in each of next 5 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 5 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptr, sc in each of next 2 sts, fptr, sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, rep between * once \Diamond , fptrtr around next post st, sc in next st, fptr around same st as last post st, sc in each of next 2 sts, fptr around post of next st, sc in next st, fptrtr around same st as post st, sc in next st, rep between $\Diamond \Diamond$ once, sc in each of next 2 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 5 sts, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 4 sts, *ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3*, sc in each of next 12 sts, rep between * once, sc in each of next 4 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 4 sts, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in next st, *sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross*, rep between * once, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, **bpdtr cross** (see Special Stitches), sc in each of next 2 sts, fpdtr cross, rep between * twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts] twice, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 6 sts. turn.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, *ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3*, sc in each of next 16 sts, rep between * once, sc in each of next 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 5 sts, turn.

Row 13: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in next st, \Diamond *ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice*, sc in next st, **fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptr, sc in each of next 2 st, fptr, sc in next st, fpdtr cross** sc in next st, ch 3, sc in each of next 8 sts, ch 3, sc in next st, rep between ** once, sc in next st, rep between * once \Diamond , sc in each of next 4 sts, **fptrtr/fptr split** (see Special Stitches), fptr/fptrtr split (see Special Stitches), sc in each of next 4 sts, rep between $\Diamond \Diamond$ once, sc in next st, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 7 sts, turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each of first 7 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, *ch 3, [sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 16 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3*, sc in each of next 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 5 sts,



rep between * once, sc in each of next 2 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in next st, \Diamond *sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross*, rep between * once, sc in each

of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch $3\Diamond$, sc in each of next 6 sts, fptr twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep between $\Diamond\Diamond$ once, sc in each of next 4 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Rows 16–63: [Rep rows 8–15 consecutively] 6 times.

Rows 64 & 65: Rep rows 8 and 9.

Row 66: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 4 sts, turn.

LEFT SIDE

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in next st, [sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross] twice, sc in next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (*53 sts*)

Rows 2–33: Work in **established pattern** (see Pattern Notes). At end of last row, fasten off.

RIGHT SIDE

Row 1 (RS): Sk next 26 sts on row 66, join with sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 3 sts, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptrtr cross, sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in each of next 3 sts, [ch 3, sc in each of next 4 sts] twice, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn. (54 sts)

Rows 2–33: Work in established pattern.

BACK

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, ch 3, sc in each of last 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 15 sts, ch 26, work across top of Left Side, sc in each of next 15 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 18 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, turn. (107 sts)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in next st, ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice, \diamond *sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in next st, fptr, sc in each of next 2 sts, fptr, sc in next st, fpdtr cross, sc in next st*, ch 3, sc in each of next 8 sts, ch 3, rep between * once \diamond , sc in back bar of each of next 26 chs, rep between $\diamond \diamond$ once, ch 3, [sc in each of next 4 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in next st, crooked fpdtr cross, sc in each of last 7 sts, turn. (*133 sts*)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 7 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 2 sts, *ch 3, [sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3, sc in each of next 16 sts, ch 3] twice, sc in each of next 6 sts, ch 3*, sc in each of next 12 sts, rep between * once, sc in each of next 2 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 4: Rep row 15 on Front.

Rows 5–92: [Rep rows 8–15 of Front consecutively] 11 times.

Rows 93 & 94: Rep rows 8 and 9 of Front.

Row 95: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of next 120 sts, closing sc twice, sc in each of last 4 sts, turn.

Rows 96 & 97: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.


EDGING

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, with RS facing and size H hook, join with sl st in end of first row, sl st in each row across. Fasten off.

Row 2: Working in ends of rows on opposite side, rep row 1 of Edging.

NECK EDGING

Rnd 1: With WS facing and size H hook, join with sc in bottom right-hand corner of neck opening, evenly sp 25 sc across to bottom left-hand corner of neck opening, 3 sc in corner, working in ends of rows around neck opening, sc evenly sp around to beg sc, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.



SHAWL COLLAR

Row 1: Ch 27, sc in back bar of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each ch across, sl st in last sc on row 1, sl st in next st, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sk first 2 sl sts, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, sl st in each of next 2 sts on row 1, turn.

Rows 4–43: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 20 times.

Row 44: Rep row 3.

Row 45: Ch 1, hdc in back lp of each of first 13 sts, hdc in back lp of each of last 13 sts, sl st in each of next 2 sts on row 1, turn.

Row 46: Ch 1, sk first 2 sl sts, sc in back lp of each of first 13 sts, hdc in back lp of each of last 13 sts, turn.

Rows 47–54: [Rep rows 45 and 46 alternately] 4 times.

Rows 55–98: [Rep rows 4 and 3] 22 times. At end of last row, fasten off.

FINISHING

Overlapping beg of Shawl Collar in front of end of Shawl Collar, sew first and last rows of each side to center front opening.

Fold down Shawl Collar.

BELT

Strips

Make 3.

Leaving 6-inch end at beg, with size H hook, ch 201, sc in back bar of 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Leaving 6-inch end, fasten off.

Braid

Holding all 3 Strips tog, using 6-inch ends, tie Strips tog as close to end of Strips as possible.

Braid Strips tog.

Using 6-inch ends, tie ends of Strips tog as close to end as possible.


Fringe

Cut 18 strands of yarn each 12 inches in length.

Holding 9 strands tog, fold in half, pull fold through end of Braid, pull all ends including ends tied tog, through fold. Pull to tighten. Trim ends if desired.

Holding 9 strands tog, rep on rem end of Belt.


Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post st on previous row.

Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.




Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.




Chain Color Change (ch color change) Yo with new color. draw through last lp on hook.



Double Crochet Color Change (dc color change) Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
