

Ice Cream Cone Doily & Napkin Ring

SKILL LEVEL

■ ■ ■ □ INTERMEDIATE

FINISHED SIZES

Doily: 7¾ inches in diameter

Napkin Ring: 2 x 2¾ inches

MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton (350 yds per ball):
 - 1 ball each #210 antique white, #310 copper mist, #493 French rose and #420 cream
 - 1 yd #494 victory red
- Size 2/2.20mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Rnds 1–3 = 1½ inches; 5 dc = ½ inches; 4 dc rnds = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of rounds counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCH

Picot: Ch 4, sl st in last sc.

DOILY

Rnd 1 (RS): With antique white, ch 6, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch to form a ring, ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join in first sc. (12 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in same sc, ch 1, [2 dc in next sc, ch 1] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), [dc in next dc, ch 1] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in same ch-1 sp, [ch 5, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp] 11 times, ch 2, dc in beg sc to position hook in center of last ch-5 lp. (12 ch-5 lps)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same ch lp, ch 6, [sc in next ch-5 lp, ch 6] around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 6 (counts as first dc, ch 3), sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 3, [dc in next sc, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 3] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-6. (12 dc, 24 ch-3 lps)

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in same dc, ch 7, [2 dc in next dc, ch 7] around,

join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (12 ch-7 sps, 24 dc)

Rnd 8: Ch 3, dc in same dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in ch-7 lp, ch 3, [2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next ch-7 lp, ch 3] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 9: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 6, [2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 6] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (12 ch-6 lps, 72 dc)

Rnd 10: Ch 3, dc in same dc, *fpdc (see *Stitch Guide*) around next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, fpdc around next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 3**, 2 dc in next dc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **,

join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24 ch lps, 96 dc)

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in same dc, *dc in next dc, fpdc around next fpdc, dc in each of next 2 dc, fpdc around next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 5**, 2 dc in next dc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (12 lps, 120 dc)

Rnd 12: Ch 3, dc in same dc, *[dc in each of next 2 dc, fpdc around fpdc] twice, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next ch-5 lp, ch 3**, 2 dc in

next dc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24 lps, 144 dc)

Rnd 13: Ch 3, dc in same dc, *[fpdc around next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, fpdc around next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 5**, 2 dc in next dc, rep from * around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (12 ch lps, 168 dc)

ICE CREAM

Note: Work Ice Cream on each cone alternating [French rose, cream and copper mist] 4 times.

Row 1 (RS): Join Ice Cream in first dc with sc, [ch 3, sc in next dc] 13 times, turn. (13 ch-3 sps)

Row 2: Working behind row 1 into dc sts of rnd 13, ch 5, sc in 5th dc, ch 5, sc in 10th dc, ch 5, sc in 14th dc, turn. (3 ch-5 lps)

Row 3: Ch 3, sc in ch-5 lp, (ch 3, sc in ch-5 lp) 4 times in same ch-5 lp, ch 3, sc in next sc, *(ch 3, sc in ch-5 sp) 4 times in next ch-5 lp, ch 3, sc in next sc, rep from * once, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, working behind row 3 and into ch-5 lps of row 2,

sc in center of ch-5 lp, [ch 3, sc in next ch-5 lp] twice, ch 3, sc in last sc, turn. (4 ch-3 lps)

Row 5: Ch 3, sc in ch-3 lp ch 3, sc in same ch 3 lp, [ch 3, sc in next sc, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 lp) 3 times] across, ending with ch 3, sl st in last st, turn.

Row 6: Working behind previous row into ch-3 sps of row 4, sl st to center of lp, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 lp] 3 times, turn. (3 ch-3 lps)

Row 7: *Ch 3, sc in ch-3 lp of row 6, [ch 3, sc in same ch-3 lp] 3 times, ch 3, sc in next sc, rep from * across, turn.

Row 8: Sl st to center of ch-3 lp of row 6, ch 1, sc in same st, ch 3, sc in next ch lp, ch 3, sc in next ch lp, turn.

Row 9: Sl st in ch-3 lp, ch 1, sc in same ch lp, **picot** (see *Special Stitch*), ch 3, sl st in next ch lp. Fasten off.

NAPKIN RING

FIRST CONE

Row 1 (WS): Beg at base of Cone with antique white, ch 8, dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each rem ch across, turn. (6 sts)



Row 2 (RS): Ch 3, dc in same dc, **fpdc** (see *Stitch Guide*) around next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, fpdc around next dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (8 sts)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next dc, **bpdc** (see *Stitch Guide*) around next post st, dc in each of next 2 dc, bpdc around next post st, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (10 sts)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in same dc, [dc in each of next 2 dc, fpdc around next post st] twice, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (12 sts)

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, [bpdc around next post st, dc in each of next 2 dc] twice, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (14 sts)

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next dc, [fpdc around next post st, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, fpdc around next post st, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (16 sts)

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, [bpdc around next post st, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, 2 dc in last dc, turn. (18 sts)

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, [fpdc around next post st, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, fpdc around next post st, dc in each of next 3 dc, 2 dc in last dc, turn. (20 sts)

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 3, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

2ND CONE

Row 1: With WS facing, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) antique white in opposite side of foundation ch of row 1 of First Cone, ch 3, dc in each of next 5 chs, turn. (6 sts)

Rows 2–9: Rep rows 2–9.

Row 10: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

Row 11: Holding row 10 of Cones tog and working through top lps of each section, sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

ICE CREAM TOPPER

FRENCH ROSE

Rnd 1: With French rose, ch 20, join in first ch to form a ring, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, ch 3, [sc in next ch, ch 3] around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Working in opposite side of foundation ch of rnd 1, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, [ch 4, sk each of next 4 chs, sc in next ch] 3 times, ch 4, join in beg sc. (4 ch-4 lps)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc in sc, [ch 3, sc in next ch] 4 times, ch 3, rep from * around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

COPPER MIST

Rnd 1: With copper mist, ch 16, join in first ch to form a ring, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, ch 3, [sc in next ch, ch 3] around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Working in opposite side of foundation ch of rnd 1, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, [ch 4, sk each of next 3 chs, sc in next ch] 3 times, ch 4, join in beg sc. (4 ch-4 lps)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc in sc, [ch 3, sc in next ch] 4 times, ch 3, rep from * around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

CREAM

Rnd 1: With cream, ch 9, join in first ch to form a ring, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, ch 3, [sc in next ch, ch 3] around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Working in opposite side of foundation ch of rnd 1, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, [ch 4, sk each of next 2 chs, sc in next


ch] twice, ch 4, join in beg sc.
(3 ch-4 lps)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc in sc, [ch 3, sc in next ch] 4 times, ch 3, rep from * around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

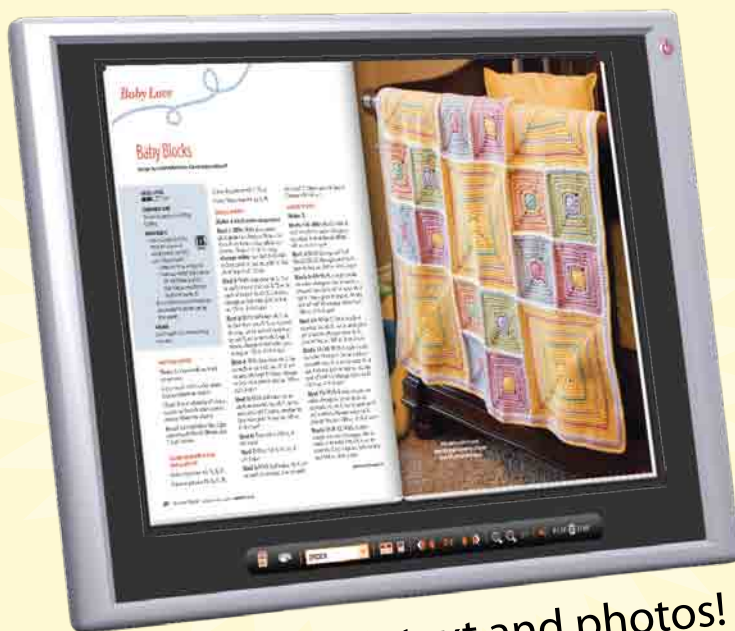
CHERRY

Row 1: With victory red, ch 4, 5 dc in first ch of ch-4, draw up a lp, remove hook, insert hook in top of first dc, pick up dropped lp and draw through st on hook, ch 1. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

With French rose on bottom, stack copper mist next, cream on top of copper mist and the cherry at center, sew pieces top at center. Sew Ice Cream Topper centered to front top of First Cone. 

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
