## FINISHED SIZES

Instructions given fit woman's size 5–6½ (*small*); changes for 7½–9 (*medium*) and 9½–10½ (*large*) are in [ ]

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Fits foot length up to 8¾ inches (*small*) [9½ inches (*medium*), 10½ inches (*large*)]

## MATERIALS

- Plymouth Yarn Gina medium (worsted) weight wool yarn (1¾ oz/109 yds/50g per ball):
  - 2 balls #7 multi-colored
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

## GAUGE

17 sc = 4 inches; granny square = 4 inches

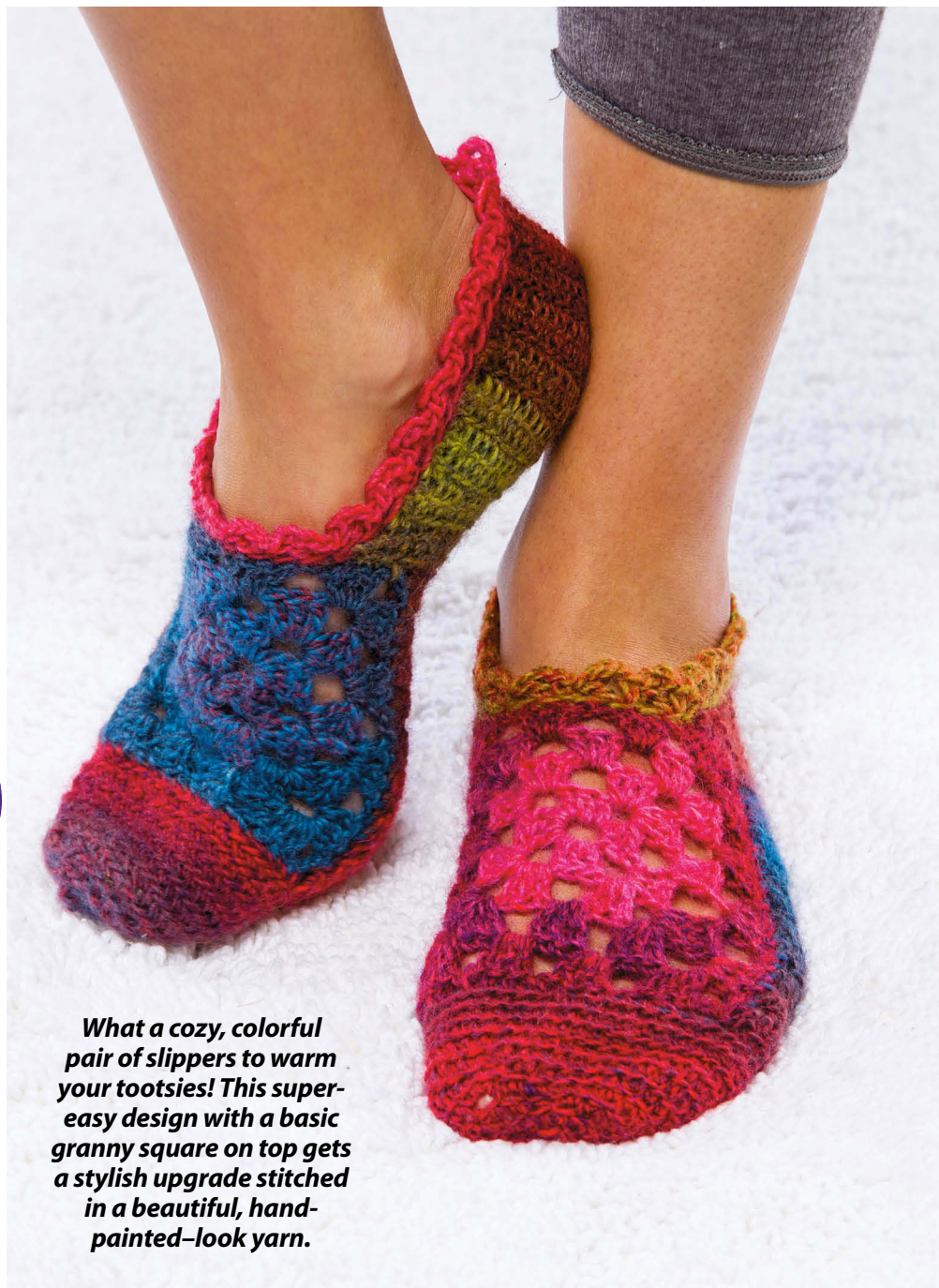
## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Do not join rounds unless otherwise stated; place stitch marker to mark rounds.



*What a cozy, colorful pair of slippers to warm your tootsies! This super-easy design with a basic granny square on top gets a stylish upgrade stitched in a beautiful, hand-painted-look yarn.*

## SLIPPER

Make 2.

### GRANNY SQUARE

**Rnd 1:** Ch 6, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) to form a ring, **ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), 2 dc in ring, ch 3, [3 dc in ring, ch 3] 3 times, join in beg ch-3, turn. (12 dc, 4 ch-3 sps)

**Rnd 2:** (Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch-3 corner sp, ch 1] 3 times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn.

**Rnd 3:** (Ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, [(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 3 times, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch sp, ch 1, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn.

**Rnd 4:** (Ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] twice, ch 1, rep from \* 3 times, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

### TOE

**Rnd 1:** Ch 6, join to form a ring, work 6 [8, 10] sc in ring, do not join, place marker and move as work progresses.

**Rnd 2:** Working in back lps (see *Stitch Guide*) of sts, sc around, inc 6 sc evenly sp around. (12 [14, 16] sc)

**Rnds 3–6:** Rep rnd 2. (36 [38, 40] sc)

**Rnds 7–11 [7–12, 7–13]:** Working in back lp of each st, sc around. At the end of last rep, **do not fasten off.**

### FOOT

**Row 1:** Now working in rows, continue to work in back lps of sts, sc in each of next 20 [22, 24] sc of Toe, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each of next 20 [22, 24] sc, turn.

Rep row 2 until Foot width matches width of Granny Square (4 inches). At the end of last rep, leaving 24-inch length, fasten off.

Position Granny Square on rem sts of Toe and each side of Foot on each side of Granny Square. With rem length, sew Foot and Toe to 3 sides of Granny Square.



### HEEL

**Row 1:** With RS facing, working on rem side of Granny Square and working in back lps only, join yarn with sc in 3rd sc to right of corner ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in each of next 20 [22, 24] sc across Foot, sc in next ch-3 sp of corner of Granny Square, sc in each of next 3 dc of corner, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Working in back lp of sts, ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 3:** Rep row 2.

**Row 4:** Working in back lp of sts, ch 1, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn. (29 [31, 33] sc)

**Rows 5–9:** Rep row 4. (34 [36, 38] sc)

Rep row 2 until Slipper measures 8¾ [9½, 10½] inches from beg. At the end of last rep, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off. Fold Heel in half and sew center back Heel closed.

### TRIM

**Rnd 1:** Now working in rnds, join yarn with sc at center back Heel seam, sc evenly sp around entire outer edge, join in beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, dc) in first sc, sk next sc, [(sc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, sk next sc] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off. **CW**

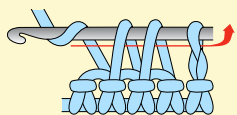

### Single crochet decrease (sc dec):

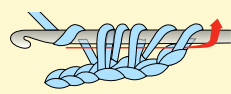
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

### Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):

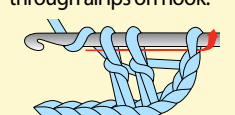
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

### Double crochet decrease (dc dec):

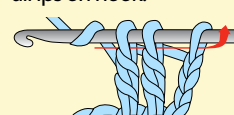
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



Example of 2-dc dec

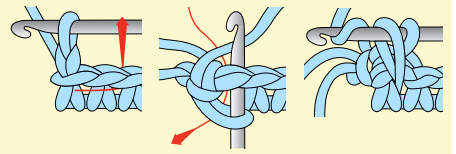
### Treble crochet decrease (tr dec):

Hold back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

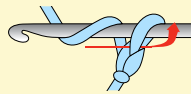


Example of 2-tr dec

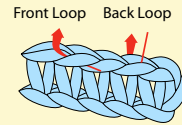
**Reverse single crochet (reverse sc):** Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.



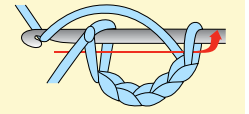
**Chain (ch):** Yo, pull through lp on hook.



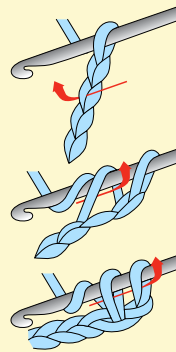
**Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)**



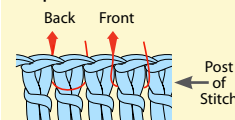
**Slip stitch (sl st):** Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



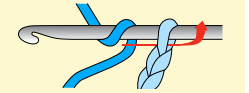
**Single crochet (sc):** Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



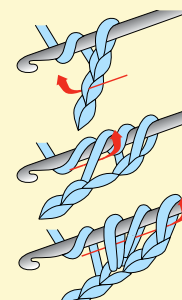
**Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp):** When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



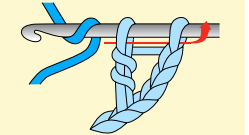
**Chain color change (ch color change)** Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



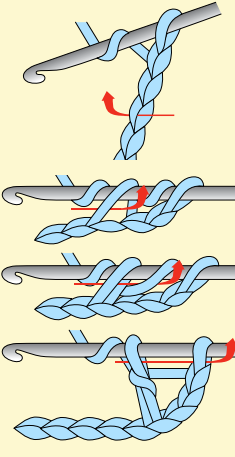
**Half double crochet (hdc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



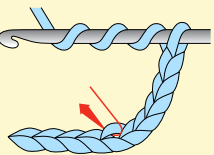
**Double crochet color change (dc color change)** Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



**Double crochet (dc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



**Double treble crochet (dtr):** Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



**Treble crochet (tr):** Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
