

Materials for Adult

- Patons Classic Merino Wool medium (worsted) weight yarn (3½ oz/223 yds/100g per ball): 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] balls #00208 burgundy (A) 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] balls #00205 deep olive (B) 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] balls #00206 russet (C) 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] balls #00212 royal purple (D)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers
- 6 matching 1-inch buttons
- Sewing needle and matching thread



INSTRUCTIONS (for adult)

Back

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 63 [69, 75, 81, 90]; dc in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*) and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. (61 [67, 73, 79, 88] dc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and beg 3 sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 *(counts as a dc on this and following rows)*; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 7, change to A in last dc; cut D.

Rows 8 & 9: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 9, change to B in last dc; cut A.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 11, change to C in last dc; cut B.

Rep rows 4–11 until piece measures 13 inches from beg, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Armhole Shaping

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 1 (WS): Hold piece with WS facing you; sk first 6 [6, 6, 9, 12] dc; join appropriate color with sl st in next dc; ch 1, sc in same dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 5 [5, 5, 8, 11] dc and turning ch-3, turn, leaving rem dc and turning ch-3 unworked.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn. **Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ [9, 9¹/₂, 10, 10¹/₂] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Note: Place markers 13 [16, 18, 17, 18] dc in from side edges for shoulders.

Right Front

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 36 [39, 42, 45, 51]; dc in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*) and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. (*34 [37, 40, 43, 49] dc*)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and beg 3 sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 *(counts as a dc on this and following rows)*; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 7, change to A in last dc; cut D.

Rows 8 & 9: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 9, change to B in last dc; cut A.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 11, change to C in last dc; cut B.

Rep rows 4–11 until piece measures 13 inches from beg, ending with a RS row. Fasten off.

Armhole Shaping

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 1 (WS): Hold piece with WS facing you; sk first 6 [6, 9, 9, 12] dc; join appropriate color in next dc; ch 1, sc in same dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures 8½ [9, 9½, 10, 10½] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Left Front

Work same as Right Front to Armhole Shaping.

Armhole Shaping

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 1 (WS): Hold piece with WS facing you; join appropriate color in first dc; ch 1, sc in same dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 5 [5, 5, 8, 11] dc and turning ch-3, turn, leaving rem dc and turning ch-3 unworked.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ [9, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$, 10, 10 $\frac{1}{2}$] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Sleeve

Make 2.

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 39; dc in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*) and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. (*37 dc*)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and 3 beg sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (*counts as a dc on this and following rows*), dc in first sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * to last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last sc, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn. (*39 dc*)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-3; sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in first sc and in next sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc; dc in next sc, 2 dc in last sc, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn. (*41 dc*)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 3 dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last dc and turning ch-3; sc in last dc and in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in first 3 sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc; dc in next sc, 2 dc in last sc, changing to A in last dc; cut D, turn. (43 dc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch turning ch-3, turn.

Row 9: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 11: Ch 3, dc in first sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * to last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last sc, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn. (45 dc)

For Size Small Only

Rows 12–27: [Work rows 4–11] twice. (57 dc at end of row 27)

Continue with For All Sizes.

For Size Medium Only

Rows 12–27: [Work rows 4–11] twice. (57 dc at end of row 27)

Rows 28 & 29: Rep rows 4 and 5. (59 dc at end of row 29)

Continue with For All Sizes.

For Size Large Only

Rows 12–35: [Work rows 4–11] 3 times. (63 dc at end of row 35)

Continue with For All Sizes.

For Size X-Large Only

Rows 12–35: [Work rows 4–11] 3 times. (63 dc at end of row 35)

Rows 36 & 37: Rep rows 4 and 5. (65 dc at end of row 37)

Continue with For All Sizes.

For Size 2/3X-Large Only

Rows 12–43: [Work rows 4–11] 4 times. (69 dc at end of row 43)

Continue with For All Sizes.

For All Sizes

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 28 [30, 36, 38, 44]: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch turning ch-3, turn.

Row 29 [31, 37, 39, 45]: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 18½ [18½, 18, 18, 17½] inches from beg, ending with RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Assembly

Sew shoulder seams to markers. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Edging

Hold Cardigan with RS facing you and Right Front edge at top; join A with sl st in end of row 1 of Right Front; ch 1, sc in same sp; working around outer edge of Cardigan, sc evenly spaced to first sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Finishing

Step 1: Fold upper corners of Fronts to form lapels. To secure lapels to Fronts, with sewing needle and matching thread, sew 1 button to corner of each lapel.

Step 2: Sew rem buttons to Left Front, having top button at beg of lapel shaping, bottom button 1 inch from lower edge, and rem 2 buttons spaced evenly between.

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 45 [48, 51, 54, 57]; dc in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*) and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. (43 [46, 49, 52, 55] dc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and beg 3 sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 *(counts as a dc on this and following rows)*; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 7, change to A in last dc; cut D.

Rows 8 & 9: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 9, change to B in last dc; cut A.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 11, change to C in last dc; cut B.

Rep rows 4-11 until piece measures 7 [$8\frac{1}{2}$, $9\frac{1}{2}$, $10\frac{1}{2}$, 12] inches from beg, ending with a RS row.







Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.









Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ [6, 6, 7, $7\frac{1}{2}$] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Note: Place markers 10 [10, 11, 10, 10] dc in from side edges for shoulders.

Right Front

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 27 [27, 30, 30, 33]; dc in 4th ch from hook *(beg 3 sk chs count as a dc)* and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. *(25 [25, 28, 28, 31] dc)*

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and beg 3 sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 *(counts as a dc on this and following rows)*; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 7, change to A in last dc; cut D.

Rows 8 & 9: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 9, change to B in last dc; cut A.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep rows 4 and 5. At end of row 11, change to C in last dc; cut B.

Rep rows 4–11 until piece measures 7 [8½, 9½, 10½, 12] inches from beg, ending with a RS row. Fasten off.

Armhole Shaping

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 1 (WS): Hold piece with WS facing you; sk first 3 [3, 3, 6, 6] dc; join appropriate color in next dc; ch 1, sc in same dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures 5½ [6, 6, 7, 7½] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Left Front

Work same as Right Front to Armhole Shaping.

Armhole Shaping

Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 1 (WS): Hold piece with WS facing you; join appropriate color in first dc; ch 1, sc in same dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 [2, 2, 5, 5] dc and turning ch-3, turn, leaving rem dc and turning ch-3 unworked.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until armhole measures 5½ [6, 6, 7, 7½] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Sleeve

Make 2.

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 24 (24, 24, 27, 27]; dc in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*) and in each rem ch, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. (22 [22, 22, 25, 25] dc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and 3 beg sk chs; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (*counts as a dc on this and following rows*), dc in first sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * to last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last ch-3 sp; 2 dc in last sc, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn. (24 [24, 24, 27, 27] dc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to turning ch-3; sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in first sc and in next sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc; dc in next sc, 2 dc in last sc, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn. (26 [26, 26, 29, 29] dc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 3 dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last dc and turning ch-3; sc in last dc and in 3rd ch of turning ch-3, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in first 3 sc; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc; dc in next sc, 2 dc in last sc, changing to A in last dc; cut D, turn. *(28 [28, 28, 31, 31] dc)*

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch turning ch-3, turn.

For Size 4 Only

Row 9: Rep row 3, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. *(30 dc)*

Row 10: Rep row 4.

Row 11: Rep row 5, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn. *(32 dc)*

Row 12: Rep row 6.

Row 13: Rep row 7, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn. *(34 dc)*

Row 14: Rep row 8.

Row 15: Rep row 3, changing to A in last dc; cut D, turn. *(36 dc)*

Continue with For All Sizes.

For Size 6 Only

Row 9: Rep row 3, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. *(30 dc)*

Row 10: Rep row 4.

Row 13: Rep row 7, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn. *(34 dc)*

Row 14: Rep row 8.

Row 15: Rep row 3, changing to A in last dc; cut D, turn. *(36 dc)*

Row 16: Rep row 4.

Row 17: Rep row 5, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. *(38 dc)*

Row 18: Rep row 6.

Row 19: Rep row 7, changing to C in last dc; cut B, turn. *(40 dc)*

Row 21: Rep row 3, changing to D in last dc; cut C, turn. *(45 dc)*

Row 22: Rep row 4.

Row 23: Rep row 5, changing to A in last dc; cut D, turn. (*47 dc*)

Row 24: Rep row 6.

Row 25: Rep row 7, changing to B in last dc; cut A, turn. *(49 dc)*

For All Sizes Note: Work rem rows in same color sequence.

Row 16 [20, 20, 22, 26]: Ch 1, sc in first dc; *ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc and turning ch-3; ch 3, sk last 2 dc, sc in 3rd ch turning ch-3, turn.

Row 17 [21, 21, 23, 27]: Ch 3; *2 dc in next ch-3 sp; dc in next sc; rep from * across, changing to next color in last dc; cut old color, turn.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 9½ [11½, 14, 15, 17] inches from beg, ending with RS row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Assembly

Sew shoulder seams to markers. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Right Front Edging

Row 1 (RS): Hold Cardigan with RS facing you and Right Front edge at top; join A with sl st in end of row 1 of Right Front; ch 1, sc in same sp; working in ends of rows of Right Front, sc evenly spaced to top of Right Front, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in **back lps** *(see page 28)* only, sc in each sc. Fasten off.

Left Front Edging

Row 1 (RS): Hold Cardigan with RS facing you and Left Front edge at top; join A with sl st in end of last row of Left Front; ch 1, sc in same sp; working in ends of rows of Left Front, sc evenly spaced to row 1, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each sc.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Finishing

Step 1: Fold upper corners of Fronts to form lapels. To secure lapels to Fronts, with sewing needle and matching thread, sew 1 button to corner of each lapel.

Step 2: Sew rem buttons to Left Front, having top button at beg of lapel shaping, bottom button 1 inch from lower edge, and rem button spaced evenly between.
