## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

$43 / 4$ inches wide at widest point $x$ $71 / 2$ inches long

## MATERIALS

- Lily Sugar'n Cream medium (worsted) weight cotton yarn ( $21 / 2 \mathrm{oz} / 120 \mathrm{yds} / 71 \mathrm{~g}$ per ball): 1 ball \#100084 sage green
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle and thread
- 2-inch metal ring
- 3-inch metal ring
- 18 mm button


## GAUGE

$9 \mathrm{sc}=2$ inches; 8 sc rows $=$ $13 / 4$ inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.
Chain-2 at beginning of round counts as first half double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## TOWEL HOLDER

## LARGE RING

Rnd 1: Join (see Pattern Notes) to 3 -inch ring, ch 1 , work 56 sc around ring (see illustration on next page), join in beg sc.
Rnd 2: Ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), hdc in each sc around, join in beg ch-2. (56 hdc)
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same hdc as beg ch-1, [ch 3 , sk next hdc, sc in


This versatile design can hold a washcloth and hand towel in the bathroom, or a dishcloth and dish towel in the kitchen. It's a great item for craft fairs or to give as a gift.
next hdc] 23 times, sc in each of next 9 sc , join in beg sc, turn.
Row 4 (RS): Now working in rows, ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc . Fasten off.

## SMALL RING

Rnd 1: Join to 2-inch ring, ch 1, work 37 sc around ring, join in beg sc.
Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each sc around, join in beg ch-2, turn. (37 hdc)
Row 3: Now working in rows, ch 1 , sc in each of next 10 hdc , turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc , turn.
Row 5: Holding Large Ring in front of Small Ring, matching 10 sc of row 4 of each and working through both thicknesses, ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc , turn.


Single Crochet Around Ring
Rows 6-25: Ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc , turn.
Row 26: Ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc , ch 2 , sk next 2 sc (buttonhole made), sc in each of next 4 sc , turn.


Row 27: Ch 1, sc in each of next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in ch- 2 sp , sc in each of next 4 sc . Fasten off.
With Small Ring facing, sew button to center of row 5 . cw
