FINISHED SIZE

17 inches long x 12 inches high

MATERIALS

- America's Best size 10 crochet cotton (ecru: 400 yds per ball; solids: 350 yds per ball):
 - 2 balls each #2 black (A), #120 fudge (B) and #66 avocado (C)
 - 1 ball each #76 American beauty (D), #4 ecru (E), #10 yellow (F) and #89 camel (G)
- Sizes 3/2.10mm and 7/1.65mm steel crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Cardboard
- Polyester fiberfill
- Poly pellets
- Green sewing thread
- Sewing needle
- 6mm black glass pearl beads: 2
- Fabric glue
- 1/8-inch-diameter wooden dowel:
 - 5-inch piece
 - 6 1/2-inch piece
 - 7-inch piece
- 3/16-inch-diameter wooden dowel:
 - 8 1/2-inch piece
- 20-gauge dark annealed wire:
 - 18 inches
- Wire cutters
- Fabric stiffener
- 3 1/2-inch-long doll needle
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

With size 3 hook and 2 strands held tog: 15 sc = 2 inches;
15 sc rows = 2 inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses unless otherwise stated.

Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

Use size 3 crochet hook when using 2 strands of crochet cotton held together unless otherwise stated.

Use size 7 crochet hook when using 1 strand of crochet cotton unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Beginning scale (beg scale): (Dc, **picot**—see *Special Stitches* in top of last dc, dc) in front lp of next st, ch 1, sc in front lp of next st.

Scale: Sc in front lp of next st, (ch 1, dc, ch 2, sl st in top of last dc, dc, ch 1) in front lp of next st, sc in front lp of next st.

End scale: Sc in front lp of next st, ch 1, (dc, **picot** in top of last dc, dc) in front lp of next st.

First foundation single crochet (first foundation sc): Insert hook in same st as last st made, draw up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp on hook (*base ch made*), yo, draw through 2 lps on hook (*foundation sc made*).

Next foundation single crochet (next foundation sc): Insert hook in base ch, draw up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp on hook (*base ch made*), yo, draw through 2 lps on hook (*foundation sc made*).

Back post treble crochet (bptr): Yo twice, insert hook from back to front to back around post of specified st, draw up lp, [yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times.

Front post treble crochet (fptr): Yo twice, insert hook from front to back to front

around post of specified st, draw up lp, [yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times.

Picot: Ch 2, sl st in top of indicated st.

Small picot (sm picot): Ch 1, sl st in top of indicated st.

Extended double crochet (ext dc): Yo, insert hook in next st, draw up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp on hook, [yo, draw through 2 lps] twice.

SHIP

HULL

Rnd 1 (RS): Starting at bottom back of Ship, **with size 3 hook, 2 strands of A held tog** (see *Pattern Notes*), ch 70, sc in 2nd ch from hook, in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch, working on opposite side of ch, sc in next ch, in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first sc. (140 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 67 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 67 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, join in first sc. (146 sc)

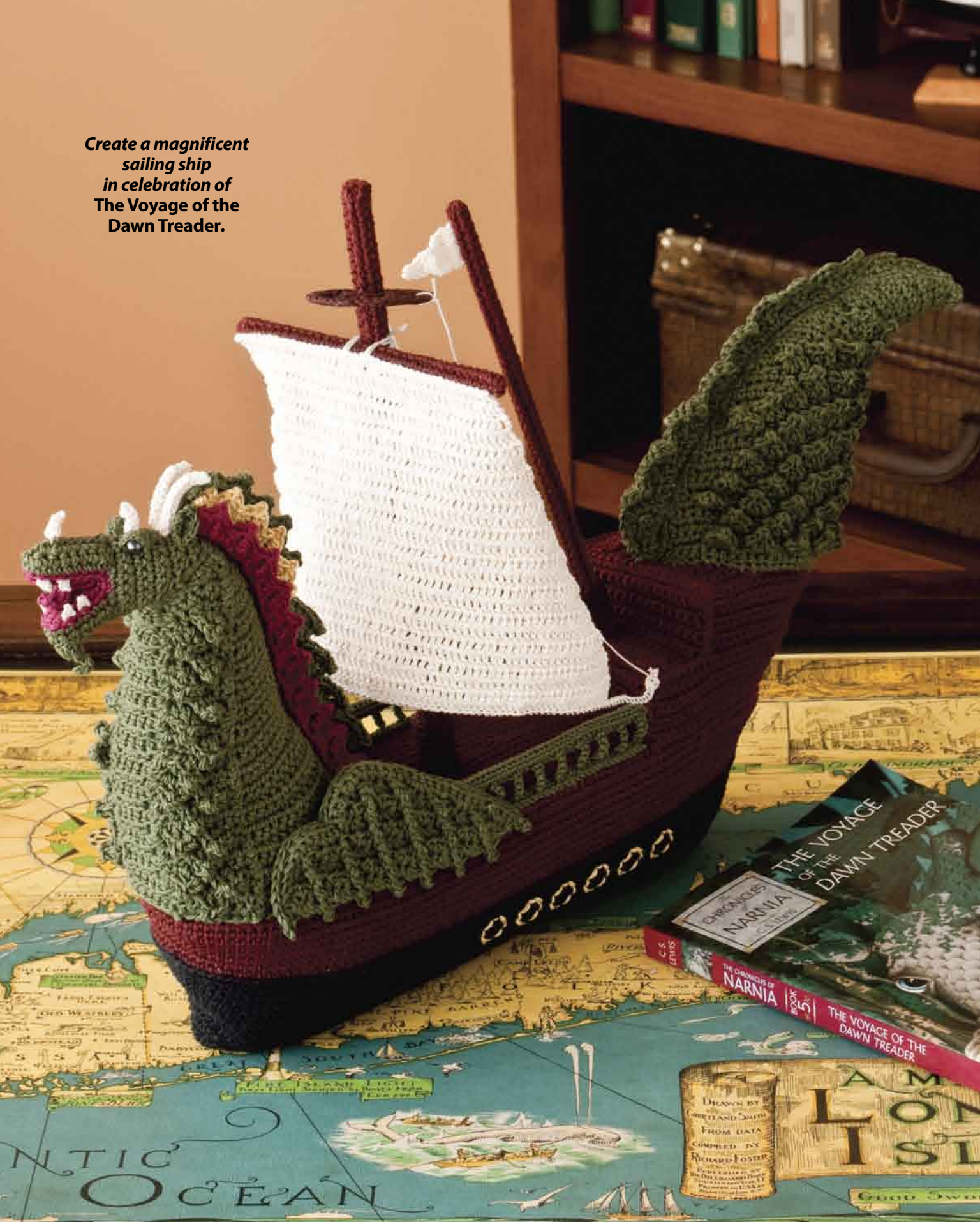
Rnds 3 & 4: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each sc around, join in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 68 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 68 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (152 sc)

Rnds 6 & 7: Rep rnds 3 and 4.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 69 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in

each of next 69 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (158 sc)

Rnds 9 & 10: Rep rnds 3 and 4.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 72 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 72 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (164 sc)

Rnds 12 & 13: Rep rnds 3 and 4.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 75 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 75 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (170 sc)

Rnds 15 & 16: Rep rnds 3 and 4.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 78 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 78 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (176 sc)

Rnd 18: Rep rnd 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 19: With RS facing, working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*) only, join 2 strands of B with sc in first sc, sc in back lp of each sc around, join in first sc.

Rnd 20: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around to last 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, join in first sc. (179 sc)

Rnds 21 & 22: Rep rnds 3 and 4.

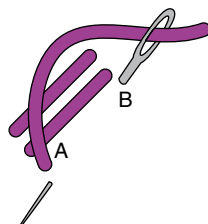
Rnds 23–25: Rep rnds 20–22. (182 sc)

Rnd 26: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around to last 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in

each of next 3 sc, join in first sc. Fasten off. (184 sc)

PORTHOLES

With 1 (36-inch) strand each F and G held tog, using **straight stitches** (see *illustration*), embroider Portholes on side of Hull as shown in photo, starting 5 inches from front curve of Hull. Work each Porthole over 3 rows, 3 sts each on rnds 14–16 with 2 sts between Portholes.

DECK

Rnd 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 65, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch, working on opposite side of ch, sc in next ch, in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch, join in first sc. (130 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 62 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 62 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, join in first sc. (136 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 63 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 63 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, join in first sc. (142 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, *sc in each of next 66 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice**, 2 sc in next sc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in first sc. (148 sc)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 67 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] twice,

2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 67 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, join. (154 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, *sc in each of next 70 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc] twice**, 2 sc in next sc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in first sc. (160 sc)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 71 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 71 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of last 2 sc, join in first sc. (166 sc)

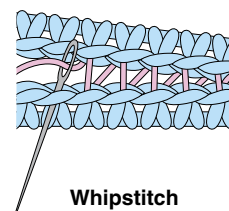
Rnd 8: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, *sc in each of next 74 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc] twice**, 2 sc in next sc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in first sc. (172 sc)

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 75 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 75 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of last 2 sc, join in first sc. (178 sc)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch-1, *sc in each of next 78 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc] twice**, 2 sc in next sc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in first sc. Fasten off. (184 sc)

ASSEMBLY

Using Deck piece as pattern, cut cardboard to fit. Working in back lps of Hull, **whipstitch** (see *illustration*), half of Deck to half of Hull. Fill bottom of Hull with poly pellets. Fill rem half of Hull with fiberfill until fiberfill is level with top of Hull.



Whipstitch

Place cardboard Deck on top of fiberfill. Continue working in back lps of Hull, whipstitching rem half of Deck to rem half of Hull.

STERN CABIN

BOTTOM DECK

Row 1 (WS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 21, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch, turn. (20 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 3–7: Rep row 2.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Rows 9–16: Rep row 2.

Row 17: Rep row 8.

Rows 18–23: Rep row 2. Fasten off at end of last row.

TOP DECK & SIDES

Row 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last sc, working in opposite side of chs, sc in next ch, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (25 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (28 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (31 sc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (34 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (37 sc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (40 sc)

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each

of next 5 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (43 sc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (46 sc)

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in each of first 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc] 3 times, sc in each of last 11 sc, turn. (49 sc)

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 15 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of last 15 sc, turn. (52 sc)

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each of first 19 sc, [sc dec (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, sc dec in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of last 19 sc, turn. (49 sc)

Rows 13 & 14: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each of first 18 sc, [sc dec in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, sc dec, sc in each of last 17 sc, turn. (46 sc)

Rows 16 & 17: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 18: Ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 8 chs, sc in each sc across, **first foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*) in same sc as last sc, **next foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*) 8 times, turn. (64 sc)

Row 19: Ch 1, sc in each of first 25 sc, [sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of last 25 sc, turn. (61 sc)

Rows 20 & 21: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each of first 24 sc, [sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of last 23 sc, turn. (58 sc)

Rows 23 & 24: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Leaving long tail, fasten off at end of last row.

ASSEMBLY

Using rows 1–7, 9–16 and 18–23 of Bottom Deck as guide, cut 3 pieces of cardboard to fit. Using Top Deck as guide, cut cardboard to fit. Working in stair-step fashion, glue cardboard piece from rows 1–7 to piece from rows 9–16. Glue cardboard piece from rows 9–16 to piece from rows 18–23. Glue cardboard piece from rows 18–23 to piece from Top Deck. While glue dries, use long tail from end of Sides to whipstitch last row of Top Deck and Sides to rem lps at back of Deck. Align row 1 of Bottom Deck to edge of Sides and whipstitch to Deck. Stuff Top Deck and Sides with fiberfill. Insert assembled cardboard pieces. Fit Bottom Deck to cardboard pieces and whipstitch ends of rows of Bottom Deck to sts and ends of rows of Top Deck and Sides.

RAILING

Make 2.

TOP RAIL & RAILING POSTS

Row 1: With size 7 hook, 1 strand C (see *Pattern Notes*), ch 62, sc in 2nd ch from hook, in each rem ch across, turn. (61 sc)

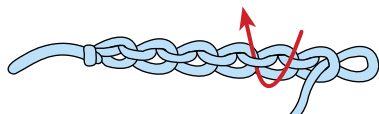
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of each sc across, turn.

Row 4: Rep row 2.

Row 5: Ch 1, fold piece in half with rem lps of row 1 and front lps of 4 tog, working in both thicknesses, sl st in first st, *ch 6 loosely, sc in **back bar** (see *illustration*) of 2nd ch from hook, in back bar of each of next 4 chs (*Railing Post made*)**, sl st in each of next 4 sts, rep from *

across, ending last rep at **, sl st in same st as last sl st, fasten off. (16 Railing Posts)

BOTTOM RAIL

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand C, ch 62 loosely, sc in back bar of 2nd ch from hook, in back bar of each rem ch across, turn. (61 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sl st in first sc, in sk ch at tip of first Railing Post on Top Rail, *sl st in each of next 3 sc, sl st in next sc, in sk ch at tip of next Railing Post on Top Rail, rep from * across. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Insert 6½-inch piece of ⅛-inch-diameter dowel into Top Rail.

TALL MAST

Row 1 (WS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 57, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (56 sc)

Rows 2–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 7: Working in ends of rows, sc dec in ends of rows 5 and 4, sc dec in ends of rows 3–1. Leaving long tail, fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

With long tail, whipstitch sc dec on row 7 to rem lps of chs at beg of row 1. Insert 8½-inch piece of ⅜-inch-diameter dowel into center of piece. Glue base of piece to base of dowel.

SHORT MAST

Row 1 (WS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 57, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (56 sc)

Rows 2–4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Working in ends of rows, sc dec in ends of rows 3–1. Leaving a long tail, fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

With long tail, whipstitch sc dec on row 4 to rem lps of chs at beg of row 1. Insert a 7-inch piece of ⅛-inch-diameter dowel into center of piece. Glue base of piece to base of dowel.

HORIZONTAL YARD

Row 1: With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 34, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (33 sc)

Rows 2–4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Working in ends of rows, sc dec in ends of rows 3–1. Leaving long tail, fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

With long tail, whipstitch sc dec on row 4 to rem lps of chs at beg of row 1. Insert a 5-inch piece of ⅛-inch-diameter dowel into center of piece. Glue base of piece to base of dowel.

TALL MAST SUPPORT

Rnd 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 10, join in first ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, sc in each rem ch around, join in first sc. (10 sc)

Rnds 2–6: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each rem sc around, join in first sc. Fasten off at end of last row.

ASSEMBLY

Apply stiffener to Support, insert Tall Mast into Support before stiffener dries.

SHORT MAST SUPPORT

Rnd 1: With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 8, join in first ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, sc in each rem ch around, join in first sc.

Rnds 2–5: Ch 1, sc in same sc

as beg ch-1, sc in each rem sc around, join in first sc. Fasten off at end of last row.

ASSEMBLY

Apply stiffener to Support, insert Short Mast into Support before stiffener dries.

LOOKOUT

Rnd 1: With size 3 hook and 2 strands B held tog, ch 10, join to form a ring, ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join in first sc. (16 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch-3 sp), sk next sc, [dc in next dc, ch 3, sk next sc] 7 times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-6. (8 dc, 8 ch-3 sps)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, 4 sc in next ch-3 sp, [sc in next dc, 4 sc in next ch-3 sp] 7 times, join in first sc. Fasten off. (40 sc)

ASSEMBLY

Apply stiffener. Position Lookout approx 1½ inches down from top of Tall Mast, glue Lookout to Tall Mast.

SAIL

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 46, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (45 sc)

Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in next sc, dc in each sc across, turn. (45 dc)

Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each dc across to last 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (47 dc)

Rows 4–24: Rep row 3.

Note: Sail should measure approximately 5 inches long at end of row 25. If necessary, work more or fewer rows in order to achieve this length.

Row 25: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each dc across to last 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, change to size 3 hook, ch 25. Fasten off. (91 dc at end of last row)

Row 26: With size 3 hook and 1 strand E, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 at beg of row 25, ch 25. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Weave wire through ch-25 of row 26, through top of sts on row 25, through ch-25 at end of row 25. Cut wire slightly longer than Sail. Shape wire to curve in Sail section and to be straight in ch-25 sections. Glue top of Sail to Horizontal Yard.

FLAG

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 4, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 sk chs count as first dc), turn. (2 dc)

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in first dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn. (3 dc)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each of first 2 dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. (4 dc)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each of first 3 dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. (5 dc)

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each of first 4 dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. (6 dc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 dc, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (6 sc)

ASSEMBLY

Stiffen Flag so it looks like the Flag is waving in the wind. Glue row 6 of Flag to top of Short Mast.

TEETH

Make 8.

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook. Fasten off.

MOUTH

Rnd 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands D held tog, ch 17, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 14 chs, 3 sc in last ch, working in opposite side of

ch, sc in each of next 15 chs, join in first sc. (34 sc)

Rnd 2: Sl st in back lp of each st around, join in first sl st. Fasten off.

TONGUE

Rnd 1 (RS): With size 7 hook and 1 strand D, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 9 chs, 3 sc in last ch, working in opposite side of chs, sc in each of next 10 chs. Fasten off. (23 sc)

ASSEMBLY

With RS of Mouth facing, sew Tongue and Teeth to inside of Mouth. Apply a dab of glue under Tongue to give it a slight curl close to the end. If desired, apply a dab of glue to inside edge of Teeth to help them stay in place better.

TOP JAW

Row 1 (RS): With RS of Mouth facing, with size 3 hook, join 2

strands C with sc in back lp of 10th sl st on rnd 2 of Mouth, sc in back lp of each of next 16 sl sts, turn. (17 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sc, [sc dec in next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of last 7 sc, turn. (15 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sc, sc dec in next 3 sts, sc in each of last 6 sc. Leaving 6-inch tail, fasten off. (13 sc)

BOTTOM JAW

Row 1 (RS): With RS of Mouth facing, with size 3 hook, join 2 strands C with sc in back lp of 2nd sl st after Top Jaw on rnd 2 of Mouth, sc in back lp of each of next 14 sl sts, turn. (15 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sc, [sc dec in next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of last 6 sc, turn. (13 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sc, sc dec in next 3 sts, sc in each of last 5 sc. Leaving 6-inch tail, fasten off. (11 sc)



ASSEMBLY

Using 6-inch tail, sew seam in row 3 on Top Jaw. Stuff with fiberfill.

Rep on Bottom Jaw.

HEAD

Row 1 (RS): With RS of Jaw assembly facing, with size 3 hook, join 2 strands C with sc in end of row 3 on Bottom Jaw right after seam, sc in end of each of next 2 rows, sc in back lp of same sl st on Mouth as last sc worked on row 1 of Bottom Jaw, sc in back lp of each of next 2 sl sts on Mouth, sc in ends of rows 1–3 on Top Jaw, sk seam, sc in ends of rows 3–1, sc in back lp of same sl st on Mouth as last sc worked on row 1 of Top Jaw, sc in back lp of each of next 2 sl sts on Mouth, sc in ends of rows 1–3 on Bottom Jaw, turn. (18 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 3 & 4: Rep row 2.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc dec in last 2 sc, turn. (16 sc)

Rows 6–9: Rep row 5. (8 sc at end of last row)

Row 10: Rep row 2. (8 sc)

Rows 11 & 12: Rep row 5. (4 sc at end of last row)

Rnd 13: Now working in rnds, ch 1, sc in each sc across, working in ends of rows, sc in end of rows 12–5, working in opposite end of same rows, sc in end of rows 5–12, join in first sc. Leaving 18-inch tail, fasten off. (20 sc)

ASSEMBLY

Using 18-inch tail, sew edges of rows 1–4 tog. Stuff Head with fiberfill.

GOATEE

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand C, ch 8, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, [sk next ch, sl st in

next ch] twice, sl st in each of last 2 chs, ch 3, 7 dc in same ch as last sl st, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Leaving 6-inch tail, fasten off.

Referring to photo, with matching green thread and sewing needle, sew Goatee to Dragon's chin.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (4 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn. (5 sc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, **beg scale** (see *Special Stitches*), sc in both lps of each of last 2 sts, turn. (1 scale, 3 sc)

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, hdc in rem lp of each of next 2 sts 1 row below, hdc in both lps of last st, turn. (3 hdc, 2 sc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, **end scale** (see *Special Stitches*), ch 1, sc in both lps of last sc, turn. (1 scale, 3 sc)

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first sc, hdc in rem lp of each of next 2 sts 1 row below, sc in both lps of each of last 2 sts, turn. (2 hdc, 3 sc)

Rows 10–17: [Rep rows 6–9 consecutively] twice.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (5 sc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, end scale, sc in both lps of last sc, turn. (1 scale, 3 sc)

Row 7: Ch 1, hdc in first st, hdc in rem lp of each of next 2 sts, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (3 hdc, 2 sc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first st, beg scale, sc in both lps of each of

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in front lp of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Rows 4–28: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 13 times, ending last rep with row 2. Fasten off at end of last row.

BACK

Row 1 (WS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands C held tog, ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (5 sc)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in first sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice, turn. (7 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn. (9 sc)

Row 4: Rep row 3. (11 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 6–21: [Rep rows 3 and 5 alternately] 8 times. (27 sc)

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each of first 8 sts, hdc in each of next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 4 sts, sc in each of last 8 sts, turn. (29 sts)

Row 23: Rep row 5.

Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, hdc in each of next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 8 sts, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (31 sts)

Row 25: Rep row 5.

Row 31: Rep row 5.

Row 32: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, hdc in each of next 12 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 12 sts, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (39 sts)

Row 33: Rep row 5.

Row 34: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 27 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of last 5 sts. Fasten off. (41 sts)

ASSEMBLY

Sew long edges of Neck Front and Back pieces tog. Sew Head to assembled Neck. Stuff assembled Neck with fiberfill.

EAR

Make 2.

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand C, ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, ch 1 (dc, ch 1, tr, ch 1, dc) in next ch, ch 1, working in rem lps on opposite side of chs, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch. Fasten off. (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 1 tr)

ASSEMBLY

Fold bottom of Ear in half, glue to top sides of Head as shown in photo.

EYELID

Make 2.

Row 1 (RS): With size 7 hook and 1 strand C, ch 7, sc in back bar of 2nd ch from hook, in back bar of each rem ch across, turn. (6 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, [sc dec in next 2 sts] 3 times, turn. (3 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc dec in 3 sc. Fasten off. (1 sc)

ASSEMBLY

With green sewing thread, sew beads to Head as shown in photo. Glue Eyelids to Head, surrounding bead eyes as shown in photo.

LONG HORN

Make 2.

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 10, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 7 chs, (sc, ch 1, sl st) in next ch, ch 1, working in opposite side of chs, sc in each of first 3 chs, sl st in each of last 6 chs, sl st in sk ch. Fold piece in half with RS tog. Sk first sl st, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off.

MEDIUM HORN

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 3, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, (sc, ch 1, sl st) in next ch, ch 1, working in opposite side of chs, sc in first ch, 3 sc in next ch, sl st in sk ch. Fold piece in half with RS tog. Sk sl st, working through both thicknesses sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off.

SMALL HORN

Row 1: With size 7 hook and 1 strand E, ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook (sc, ch 1, sl st) in next ch, ch 1, working in opposite side of chs, sc in first ch, sc in next ch, sl st in sk ch. Fold piece in half with RS tog. Sk sl st, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off. Glue all Horns to Head as shown in photo.

RED FIN

Make 2.

Row 1 (WS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands D held tog, ch 42, sc in 2nd ch from hook, in each rem ch across, turn. (41 sc)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in first st, *dc in next st, **fp**tr (see *Special*

Stitches) around next st, **sm picot** (see *Special Stitches*) in **fp**tr just made, dc in next st, sc in next st, rep from * across. Fasten off. (10 *fp*tr, 20 dc, 11 sc)

GOLD FIN

Make 2.

Row 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 1 strand each F and G held tog, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook, in each ch across, turn. (16 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, **bpdc** (see *Stitch Guide*) around next st, sc in next st, [**b**ptr (see *Special Stitches*) around next st, hdc in each of next 2 sts] 3 times, **b**ptr around next st, sc in next st, **bpdc** around next st, sc in last st, turn. (4 *b*ptr, 2 *bpdc*, 6 hdc, 4 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, **fpdc** (see *Stitch Guide*) around next st, **sm picot** in **fpdc** just made, sc in next st, *(dc, **fp**tr, **sm picot** in **fp**tr just made, dc) in next st**, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * 3 times, ending last rep at **, sc in next st, **fpdc** around next st, sc in last st. Fasten off. (4 *fp*tr, 2 *fpdc*, 18 dc, 10 sc)

Row 33: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, *hdc in rem lp of each of next 3 sts 1 row below, sc in next st*, sc in each of next 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep between * once, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (6 hdc, 10 sc)

Row 34: Ch 1, hdc in each of first 3 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, sl st in each of next 4 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 3 sts, turn. (6 hdc, 6 sc, 4 sl sts)

Row 35: Ch 1, sc in each st, turn.

Row 36: Ch 1, hdc dec in first 2 sts, sc in each of next 4 sts, sl st in each of next 4 sts, sc in each of next 4 sts, hdc dec in last 2 sts, turn. (2 hdc, 8 sc, 4 sl sts)

Row 37: Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn. (13 sc)

Row 38: Ch 1, hdc in each of first 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (4 hdc, 6 sc, 3 sl sts)

Row 39: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 40: Ch 1, hdc dec in first 2 sts, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, hdc dec in last 2 sts, turn. (4 hdc, 4 sc, 3 sl sts)

Row 41: Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of last 4 sts, turn. (10 sc)

Row 42: Ch 1, hdc dec in first 2 sts, sc in each of next 2 sts, sl st in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 2 sts, hdc dec in last 2 sts, turn. (2 hdc, 4 sc, 2 sl sts)

Row 43: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of last 3 sts, turn. (7 sc)

Row 44: Ch 1, hdc dec in first 2 sts, sc in next st, sl st in next st, sc in next st, hdc dec in last 2 sts, turn. (2 hdc, 2 sc, 1 sl st)

Row 45: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in last st. Leaving long tail, fasten off. (4 sc)

ASSEMBLY

Sew edges of Dragon Tail tog. Stuff Dragon Tail with fiberfill. Sew base of Dragon Tail to Top Deck of Stern Cabin.

TAIL FIN

Row 1: With size 3 hook and 2 strands C held tog, ch 49, [sc dec in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, 2 tr in next ch, ch 1, 3 sc around post of last tr made] 3 times, [sc dec in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, 2 dc in next ch, ch 1, 2 sc around post of last dc made] 3 times, [sc dec in

next 2 sts, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, 2 sc around post of last dc made] twice, [sc dec in next 2 sts, hdc in next ch, ch 1, sc around post of last hdc made] 3 times, sc in each of next 2 chs, sc dec in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 2: Sl st in each of first 3 sts, [hdc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in top of last hdc, sc around post of same hdc, sc in sc at base of same hdc, sl st in next st, sk next st] 3 times, [sl st in next sc, hdc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in top of last hdc, sc around post of same hdc, sc in sc at base of same hdc, sc dec, sk next st] twice, [sl st in next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in top of last dc, sc around post of same dc, sc in sc at base of same dc, sc in next st, sc dec, sk next st] 3 times, *sl st in next sc, sc in next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in top of last dc, 2 sc around post of same dc, sc in sc at base of same dc, sc in each of next 2 sts, sc dec*, sk next st, rep between * once, sl st in last st. Fasten off. Glue Tail Fin to Tail.

LEFT WING

Row 1 (RS): With size 3 hook and 2 strands C held tog, [ch 6, sl st in 3rd ch from hook] 6 times, ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 hdc in next ch, dc in next sl st, [hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next ch, dc in next sl st] 5 times, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in last ch, turn. (6 dc, 22 hdc, 1 sc)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in first st, hdc dec in next 2 sts, [bpdc around next dc, 2 hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts] 5 times, bpdc around next dc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, leave rem sts unworked, turn. (6 bpdc, 18 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 2, [fpdc around next bpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, fpdc around next bpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, turn. (6 fpdc, 16 hdc)

Row 4: Ch 2, bpdC around next fpdc, 2 dc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts, [bpdC around next fpdc, 2 hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts] 3 times, bpdC around next fpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, leave rem sts unworked, turn. (5 bpdC, 2 dc, 11 hdc)

Row 5: Ch 2, [fpdc around next bpdC, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 3 times, leave rem sts unworked, turn. (3 fpdc, 9 hdc)

Row 6: Ch 2, sk first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, bpdC around next fpdc, 2 hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts, bpdC around next fpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, leave rem sts unworked, turn. (2 bpdC, 6 hdc)

Row 7: Ch 2, fpdc around next bpdC, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, fpdc around next bpdC, hdc dec in last 2 sts. Fasten off. (2 fpdc, 4 hdc)

EDGING

Row 1: With WS facing and size 3 hook, join 2 strands C held tog with sl st in first foundation ch on Left Wing, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to top of outer curve, inc 1 st at top outer curve, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to inner curve, sl st in end of row at inner curve, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to end of Left Wing foundation ch, 2 sc in last sl st worked on foundation ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, working in back lps, 2 sc in first st, sc evenly sp across to top outer curve, inc 1 st at top outer curve, sk st before and after sl st on row 1 of Edging, sc evenly sp across to joining sl st of row 1 of Edging, sc in next sl st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, sl st in rem lp of 2nd foundation ch. Fasten off.

RIGHT WING

Row 1 (RS): With size 3 hook

and 2 strands C held tog, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, [ch 6, sl st in 3rd ch from hook] 5 times, ch 5, 2 hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc dec in next 2 sts, dc in next sl st, [2 hdc in next ch, hdc dec in next 2 sts, dc in next sl st] 5 times, 2 hdc in next ch, hdc in last ch, turn. (6 dc, 21 hdc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sl st in next st, ch 2, hdc in next st, [bpdC around next dc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, bpdC around next dc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, turn. (6 bpdC, 18 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next st, [fpdc around next bpdC, 2 hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts] 5 times, fpdc around next bpdC, hdc in next st, turn. (6 fpdc, 17 hdc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 2 sts, ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 sts, [bpdC around next fpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, bpdC around next fpdc, hdc in next st, turn. (5 bpdC, 14 hdc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 5 sts, ch 2, [2 hdc in next st, hdc dec, fpdc around next bpdC] 3 times, hdc in next st, turn. (3 fpdc, 10 hdc)

Row 6: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 3 sts, ch 2, hdc in next st, bpdC around next fpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, bpdC around next fpdc, hdc dec in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, turn. (2 bpdC, 6 hdc)

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in next st, fpdc around next bpdC, 2 hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts, fpdc around next bpdC, hdc in next st. Fasten off. (2 fpdc, 5 hdc)

EDGING

Row 1: With WS facing and size 3 hook, join 2 strands C with sl st in first foundation ch on Right Wing, 2 sc in edge of first row, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to top of

outer curve, inc 1 st at top outer curve, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to inner curve, sl st in end of row at inner curve, working in ends of rows and in sts, sc evenly sp around to end of Right Wing foundation ch, sc in end of foundation ch at beg of row 1, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, working in back lps, 2 sc in first st, sc evenly sp across to top outer curve, inc 1 st at top outer curve, sk st before and after sl st on row 1 of Edging, sc evenly sp across to joining sl st of row 1 of Edging, sc in next sl st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, sl st in rem lp of 2nd foundation ch. Fasten off.

FINAL ASSEMBLY

Using photo as a guide throughout, glue Railings to side edges of Deck between Dragon Neck and Stern Cabin. Glue Wings to sides of Dragon Neck and to Railings. Glue Tall Mast to Deck. Glue Short Mast to Bottom Deck of Stern Cabin. **Optional:** With 2 strands E, tie Horizontal Yard to Tall Mast below Lookout. Insert ends of Sail wire into front edges of Stern Cabin. Tie a long strand of E to edge of Lookout. With doll needle, insert strand into bottom front corner of lower Deck on Stern Cabin and out other corner. Tie other end of strand to edge of Lookout. Trim ends of strand. **CW**

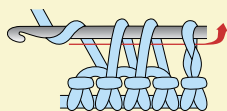

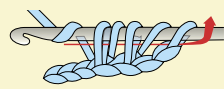

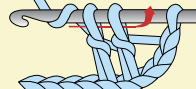
Example of 2-sc dec

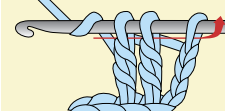
Example of 2-hdc dec

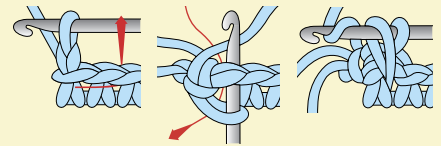
Example of 2-dc dec

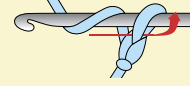

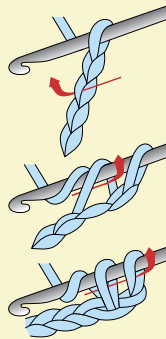

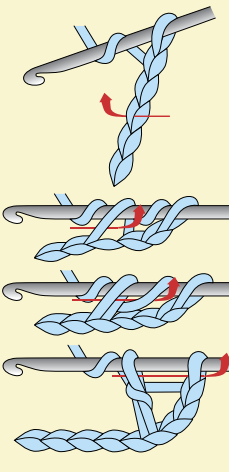
Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.



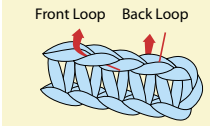
Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



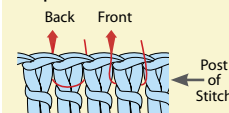

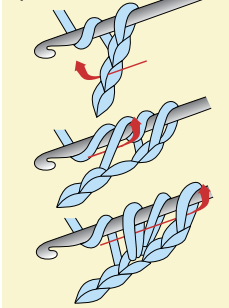

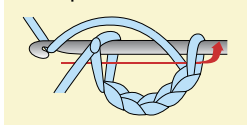

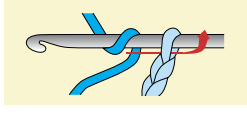

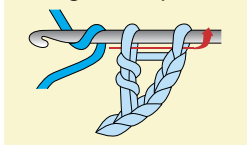
