

Ogle House Throw

1 2 3 4 5 6 INTERMEDIATE

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

36 inches wide x 55 inches long

MATERIALS

- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per skein):
 - 10 skeins #1018 cornflower
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



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GAUGE

Motif = 9½ inches square; 4 sc rows = 1 inch; 4 sc rows = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Each Square is worked in rounds and then each corner is formed by working a triangle in rows.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-5 at beginning of round counts as first double crochet and chain-2 unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-4 at beginning of round counts as first double crochet and chain-1 unless otherwise stated.

Chain-6 at beginning of round counts as first double crochet and chain-3 unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Extended double crochet

(edc): Yo, insert hook in indicated corner ch-3 sp, yo, draw up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp on hook, [yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] twice.

Corner shell: (Sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc) in corner sp.

Shell: (Sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc) in indicated sp.

THROW

SQUARE

Center

Make 24.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 6, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch to form a ring, ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join in beg sc. (16 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 5 (see *Pattern Notes*), sk next sc, dc in next sc, [ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next sc] 6 times, ch 2, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. (8 ch-2 sps, 8 dc)

Rnd 3: Sl st in next ch-2 sp, **ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), 3 dc in same sp, ch 1, [4 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1] 6 times, 4 dc in last ch-2 sp, sc in top of beg ch-3 to join. (32 dc)

Rnd 4: [Ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 9, sc in next ch-1 sp] 3 times, ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 9, join in beg sc. (4 ch-9 corner sps, 4 ch-5 sps)

Rnd 5: Sl st in next ch-5 sp, **ch 4** (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in same ch-5 sp, ch 1, (5 dc, ch 2, 5 dc) in corner ch-9 sp, ch 1, [(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-5 sp, ch 1, (5 dc, ch 2, 5 dc) in corner ch-9 sp, ch 1] 3 times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-4. Fasten off.

Rnd 6 (RS): Join in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in same corner ch-2 sp, *ch 4, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next (dc, ch 1, dc) group, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 4, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next corner ch-2 sp, rep from * twice, ch 4, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next (dc, ch 1, dc) group, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 4, join in beg sc, sl st in next corner ch-3 sp. (4 corner ch-3 sps)

Triangle

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same ch-3 sp as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, 5 sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, 4 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, 5 sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-3 sp, turn. (20 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc dec in next 2 sc, turn. (18 sc)

Rows 3–9: [Rep row 2] 7 times. (4 sc)

Row 10: Ch 1, [sc dec in next 2 sc] twice, turn. (2 sc)

Row 11: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc. Fasten off. (1 sc)

Join in same corner ch-3 sp as last sc of row 1 of previous Triangle, rep rows 1–11 until all 4 Triangles are completed.

Border

Rnd 1: Join in any corner sc of row 11 of Triangle, ch 3, 4 dc in same sc as beg ch-3, *12 dc along side of next Triangle, **edc** (see *Special Stitches*) in ch-3 corner sp of rnd 6, 12 dc in side edge of next Triangle**, 5 dc in corner sc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (116 dc, 4 edc)

ASSEMBLY

With WS of Squares facing, join in any corner, and working through both thicknesses

The vintage squares in this elegant throw were inspired by the beautiful historic landmark Guess-White-Ogle House located in Cary, N.C.



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of Squares, ch 1, sc evenly sp across. Fasten off.

Sc Squares tog in 6 strips of 4 Squares each and then join strips tog to form a 4 x 6-Square Throw.

EDGING

Rnd 1: Join yarn in 3rd dc of any corner, ch 1, [3 sc in center corner dc, sc in each dc across edge] around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Sl st in 2nd sc of corner 3-sc group, **ch 6** (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in same corner st as beg ch-6, [ch 2, sk next 2 sc, dc in next sc] rep around, working (dc, ch 3, dc) in each center sc of

each rem corner, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 3: Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, [**corner shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in same ch-3 sp, **shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in each

ch-2 sp across edge] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.
