## CHEMISE

SKILL LEVEL

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits $111 / 2$-inch fashion doll

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton ( 400 yds per ball):

125 yds \#1 white

- Size $7 / 1.65 \mathrm{~mm}$ steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- White thread
- Size $4 / 0$ sew-on snap fasteners: 5


## GAUGE

8 hdc $=1$ inch; 6 hdc rows $=1$ inch; $8 \mathrm{dc}=1$ inch; 4 dc rows $=1$ inch

## CHEMISE

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.
Chain-2 at beginning of row or round counts as first half double crochet throughout unless otherwise stated.
Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet throughout unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Picot: Ch 2, sl st in first ch of ch-2.

## BODICE

Row 1: Beg at waistline, ch 26 , hdc in 2 nd ch from hook, hdc in
each rem ch across, turn. (25 hdc)
Row 2: Ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), hdc in same st as beg ch-2, hdc in each hdc across to last hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc, turn. (27 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.
Rows 4 \& 5: Rep rows 2 and 3. (29 hdc)
Row 6: Rep row 2. (31 hdc)
Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $14 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next hdc, hdc in each of next 15 hdc , turn. (32 hdc)
Row 8: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $14 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in each of next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 15 hdc , turn. (34 hdc)
Row 9: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $15 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in each of next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 16 hdc , turn. (36 hdc)
Row 10: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $15 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next hdc, hdc in each of next $2 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next hdc, hdc in each of next 16 hdc , turn. ( 38 hdc )
Row 11: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $15 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next hdc, hdc in each of next $4 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next hdc, hdc in each of next 16 hdc , turn. Fasten off. (40 hdc)

## Front

Row 12: Sk last 11 hdc of row 11 , attach white in 12 th hdc, ch 2 , hdc in each of next 17 hdc , turn. (18 hdc)
Rows 13-15: Rep row 3.

## Right Front Shoulder

Row 16: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 4 hdc , hdc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 hdc , turn. (6 hdc)


Row 17: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 3 hdc , turn. ( 5 hdc )
Row 18: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc. Fasten off. (4 hdc)

## Left Front Shoulder

Row 16: Sk next 4 hdc of row 14 , join white with sl st in next st, ch 2 , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 4 hdc , turn. (6 hdc)
Row 17: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, turn. ( 5 hdc )
Row 18: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 2 hdc . Fasten off. (4hdc)

## Right Back Shoulder

Row 16: Attach white to last hdc of row 15 , ch 2 , hdc in each of next 5 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , turn. ( 7 hdc )

Row 17: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 4 hdc , turn. ( 6 hdc )

Rows 18-20: Rep row 3.
Row 21: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 3 hdc , turn. (5 hdc)
Row 22: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc . Fasten off. (4hdc)

## Left Back Shoulder

Row 16: Sk next 3 hdc of row 15 , attach white with sl st, ch 2 , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 5 hdc , turn. ( 7 hdc )

Row 17: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 4 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , turn. (6 hdc)
Rows 18-20: Rep row 3.
Row 21: Ch 2 , hdc in each of next 3 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , turn. (5 hdc)
Row 22: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 2 hdc . Fasten off. (4hdc)
With tapestry needle, sew shoulder seams.

## COLLAR

Row 1: Join white with sl st to side of last hdc of right shoulder row 21 , ch 2 , hdc in same st, hdc in side edge of row $22,4 \mathrm{hdc}$ along neck edge, hdc in each rem 4 hdc of row $15,4 \mathrm{hdc}$ along opposite side of neck edge to shoulder seam, hdc in side of last hdc of row 22, 2 hdc in side of beg ch-2 of row 21 of left side, turn. (18 hdc)
Row 2: [Picot (see Special Stitch), sl st in next hdc] across. Fasten off.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

Rnd 1: With RS facing, join white with sl st in 2nd sk hdc of Right Front row 15, ch 2, work 17 hdc evenly sp around armhole opening, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg ch-2. (18 hdc)


Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , join. (16 hdc)
Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 6 hdc, hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , join. (15 hdc)
Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 5 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , join. (14 hdc)
Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 5 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 6 hdc, join. (13 hdc)
Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 4 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 6 hdc, join. (12 hdc)
Rnds 7-17: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join in 2 nd ch of beg ch-2.
Rnd 18: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, picot, [hdc in next hdc, picot] around, join in beg ch-2. Fasten off.

## LEFT SLEEVE

Rnd 1: Join white with sl st in 2nd sk hdc of Left Front row 15 , ch 2 , work 17 hdc evenly sp around armhole opening, join in beg ch-2. (18 hdc)
Rnd 2: Ch 1, [ch 2, hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 7 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , join. (16 hdc)
Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 6 hdc, join. (15 hdc)
Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 5 hdc , join. (14 hdc)
Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each of next 5 hdc , join. (13 hdc)
Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in each of next

6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 4 hdc , join. (12 hdc)
Rnds 7-17: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2.
Rnd 18: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, picot, [hdc in next hdc, picot] around, join in beg ch-2. Fasten off.

## UNDERSKIRT

Row 1: With RS facing and working in opposite side of foundation ch, join white with sl st, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in same ch, [dc in each of next 3 chs, 2 dc in next ch] 6 times, turn. (32dc)
Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in each of next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc] 5 times, turn. ( 38 dc )
Row 3: Ch 3, dc in same st as beg ch-3, [dc in each of next 6 $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc] 3 times, dc in each of rem 2 dc , turn. ( 44 dc )
Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.
Rnd 5 (RS): Now working in rnds, ch 3, dc in each dc around, join in 3rd ch of ch-3, do not turn.
Rnds 6-23: Ch 3, dc in each dc around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.
Rnd 24: Ch 3, dc in next dc, picot, [dc in next dc, picot] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

## RIGHT BACK OPENING

Row 1: Join white with sl st to row 1 of Collar, ch 2, work 29 hdc evenly sp down back opening, ending with last hde in row 4 of Underskirt, turn. (30 hdc)
Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across. Fasten off.

## LEFT BACK OPENING

Row 1: Join white with sl st in side edge of row 4 of Underskirt, ch 2 , work 29 hdc evenly sp up
back opening with last hdc in row 1 of Collar. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Overlapping Left Back Opening onto Right Back Opening, sew 5 snap fasteners evenly sp down Back Opening.

## FLOUNCE SKIRT

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

V-stitch (V-st): (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.
Beginning V-st (beg V-st): Sl st in ch-1 sp, ch 4, dc in same ch-1 sp.

## SKIRT

Row 1: Ch 31, dc in 3rd ch from hook (first 2 chs count as first $d c$ ), dc in each rem ch across, turn. (30 dc)
Row 2: Beg V-st (see Special Stitches) in first dc, [sk next dc,

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits $111 / 2$-inch fashion doll

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton ( 350 yds per ball):

160 yds \#1056 chambray

- Size 00/2.70mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Sewing needle
- Chambray blue thread
- Size $4 / 0$ sew-on snap fastener


## GAUGE

4 V -sts $=11 / 2$ inches; 4 V -st rnds $=$ $11 / 2$ inches


V-st (see Special Stitches) in next st] 14 times, turn. (15 V-sts)
Row 3: Beg V-st in first ch-1 sp, V-st in each ch-1 sp across, turn.
Row 4: Rep row 3.
Rnd 5: Now working in rnds, beg V-st in first ch- 1 sp , V-st in each ch-1 sp across, join (see Pattern Notes) in 3rd ch of beg ch-4, do not turn. (15 V-sts)
Rnds 6-14: Beg V-st in first ch-1 sp, V-st in each ch-1 sp around, join in 3rd ch of ch-4, do not turn.

Rnd 15: Beg V-st in first ch-1 sp, ch 1 , [V-st in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] around, join in 3rd ch of ch-4, do not turn.
Rnd 16: Rep rnd 15.
Rnd 17: Sl st into ch- 1 sp , ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 1, $2 \mathrm{dc})$ in same ch- 1 sp , [( 2 dc , ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-1 sp of V-st] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With sewing needle and thread, sew snap fastener to row 1 of Skirt.

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

## LEFT FRONT

Row 1: Ch 2, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn. (2 sc)
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc across, turn. (4 sc)
Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. ( 6 sc )

Rows 4-7: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (14 sc)
Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn

Rows 9-16: Rep row 8.
Row 17: Ch 1, sc in each of next 12 sc . Turn, leaving last 2 sc unworked. (12 sc)
Row 18: Ch 1, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sc , sc in each of next 10 sc , turn. ( 11 sc )

Row 19: Ch 1, sc in each of next 9 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (10 sc)
Rows 20 \& 21: Rep row 8.
Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc . Turn, leaving rem 4 sc unworked. (5 sc)

Row 23: Ch 1, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 3 sc , turn. (4 sc)

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits $11 / 2$-inch fashion doll

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton (350 yds per ball):

50 yds \#12 black

- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Black thread
- Size $4 / 0$ black sew-on snap fasteners: 3
- 4 mm black beads: 3

GAUGE
8 sc $=1$ inch; 10 sc rows $=1$ inch

Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (3 sc)
Rows 25-32: Rep row 8. At the end of row 32 , fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Rows 1-16: Rep rows 1-16 of Left Front
Row 17: Sl st in each of first 2 $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 12 sc , turn. (12 sc)
Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (11 sc)

Row 19: Ch 1, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 9 sc , turn. (10 sc)
Rows 20 \& 21: Rep row 8.
Row 22: Sl st in each of next 4 sc, ch 1 , sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 4 sc , turn. (5 sc)
Row 23: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (4 sc)
Row 24: Ch 1, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 2 sc , turn. (3 sc)

Rows 25-32: Rep row 8. At the end of row 32 , fasten off.

## BACK

Row 1: Ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (16 sc)
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Rows 3 \& 4: Rep row 2.
Row 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (18 sc)
Rows 6-9: Rep row 2.
Row 10: Rep row 5. (20 sc)
Rows 11 \& 12: Rep row 2.
Row 13: Sl st in first sc, sc dec in next 2 sc , sc in each of next 14 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , leaving last sc unworked, turn. (16 sc)
Row 14: Ch 1, sc dec in next first 2 sc , sc in each of next 12 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. ( 14 sc )
Rows 15-21: Rep row 2.

## First Shoulder Shaping

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each of

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits $11 \frac{1}{2}$-inch fashion doll

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton ( 350 yds per ball):

200 yds \#479 bridal blue

- Size $7 / 1.65 \mathrm{~mm}$ steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Beading needle
- Light blue thread
- Hook and eye
- 2 mm pearl beads: 14


## GAUGE

8 hdc $=1$ inch; 6 hdc rows $=1$ inch
next 3 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (4 sc)
Row 23: Ch 1, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 2 sc , turn. (3sc)
Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc . Fasten off.

## 2nd Shoulder Shaping

Row 22: Sk next 4 sc of row 21, join black with sl st in next sc, ch 1 , sc dec in same sc and next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc , turn. (4 sc)
Row 23: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc , sc dec in next 2 sc , turn. (3 sc)
Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc . Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With tapestry needle, sew shoulder and side seams.
With sewing needle and black thread, sew 3 snap fasteners evenly sp to center front edges. Sew 1 black bead on outer edge above each snap fastener.

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.
Chain-2 at beginning of row or round counts as first half double crochet throughout unless otherwise stated.
Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet throughout unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Front post treble crochet (fptr): Yo twice, insert hook front to back to front again around vertical post of indicated st, yo, draw up a lp, [yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times.


## LEFT FRONT BODICE

Row 1: Beg at waistline, ch 13 , hdc in 2 nd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. (12 hdc)
Row 2: Ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), hdc in same hdc as beg ch-2, hdc in each hdc across, turn. ( 13 hdc )
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc, hdc in each rem hdc across, turn. (12 hdc)
Rows 4 \& 5: Rep rows 2 and 3.
Row 6: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.
Row 7: Rep row 6.
Row 8: Sl st in first 2 hdc , ch 2 , hdc in next hdc, sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next hdc, ch 2 , hdc in each rem 4 hdc , turn. (10 sts)
Row 9: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 hdc , sk sl st, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 4 sts , sk last 2 sl sts, turn. (10 hdc)
Row 10: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 sts, hdc in each rem st, turn. ( 9 hdc )
Row 11: Rep row 10. (8 hdc)
Row 12: Rep row 6.
Row 13: Rep row 10. (7hdc)
Row 14: Rep row 2. (8 hdc)
Row 15: Ch 2, hdc dec in next

2 sts, hdc in each of next 4 sts, 2 hdc in last st, turn. ( 8 hdc )
Row 16: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 hdc , sc in each of next 3 hdc, sk last hdc, turn. ( 7 sts)
Row 17: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $2 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st in each of next 4 sts. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT BODICE

Row 1: Beg at waistline, ch 13, hdc in 2 nd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. (12 hdc)
Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $10 \mathrm{hdc}, 2$ hdc in next hdc, turn. (13 hdc)
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 10 hdc , hdc dec in last 2 hdc , turn. (12 hdc)
Rows 4 \& 5: Rep rows 2 and 3.
Row 6: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.
Row 7: Rep row 6.
Row 8: Ch 2, hdc in each of next $4 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next hdc, sc in each of next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 2 hdc , leaving rem 2 hdc unworked, turn. (10 sts)

Row 9: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sk next sl st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in rem 4 sts, turn. (10 hdc)
Row 10: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across to last 2 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 sts, turn. ( 9 hdc )
Row 11: Rep row 10. (8 hdc)
Row 12: Rep row 6.
Row 13: Rep row 10. (7 hdc)
Row 14: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 5 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, turn. ( 8 hdc )
Row 15: Ch 2, hdc in same st as beg ch-2, hdc in each of next 5 hdc , hdc dec in last 2 hdc , turn. ( 8 hdc )
Row 16: Sl st in first st, ch 1 , sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 4 hdc , turn. ( 7 sts )
Row 17: Sl st in each of next

4 sts, ch 1 , hdc in each of next 3 sts. Fasten off.

## LEFT BACK

Row 1: Beg at waistline, ch 10, hdc in 2 nd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. ( 9 hdc )
Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st as beg ch-2, hdc in each hdc across to last hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc, turn. (11 hdc)
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.
Row 4: Rep row 2. (13 hdc)
Rows 5-7: Rep row 3.
Row 8: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 8 hdc , leaving rem 4 sts unworked, turn. (9hdc)
Rows 9-15: Rep row 3.
Row 16: Sl st in each of next 3 sts, ch 2, hdc in each of next $4 \mathrm{hdc}, 2$ hdc in last hdc, turn. (7hdc)

Row 17: Sl st in each of next 2 hdc , sc in each of next 2 sts , hdc in each of next 3 hdc . Fasten off.

## RIGHT BACK

Rows 1-7: Rep rows 1-7 of Left Back.

Row 8: Sl st in each of next 4 sts, ch 2 , hdc in each of next 8 hdc , turn. (9 hdc)
Rows 9-15: Rep row 3.
Row 16: Ch 2, hdc in same st as beg ch-2, hdc in each of next 5 hdc, leaving rem 3 sts unworked, turn. ( 7 hdc )
Row 17: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc , sc in each of next 2 sts , sl st in each of next 2 sts. Fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY

With tapestry needle and length of bridal blue, sew WS of Right and Left Backs tog along center

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back seam. Sew Fronts and back tog at Shoulders. Sew side seams.

## FIRST SLEEVE

Rnd 1: With RS facing, join bridal blue to side seam of right underarm, ch 2 , work 12 hdc evenly sp along back armhole edge to shoulder seam, hdc in shoulder seam, 12 hdc evenly sp along front armhole edge to beg, join in beg ch-2, turn. ( 26 hdc )
Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 8 hdc, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2, turn. (24 hdc)
Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 6 hdc , hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each of next 7 hdc , join in 2 nd ch of beg ch-2, turn. (22 hdc)
Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join in beg ch-2.
Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc dec in next 2 hdc , hdc in each rem hdc around, join in beg ch-2. ( 21 hdc )
Rnds 6-15: [Rep rows 4 and 5 alternately] 5 times. ( 16 hdc )
Rnds 16-18: Rep row 4. At the end of last rep, fasten off.

## 2ND SLEEVE

Rnd 1: With RS facing, attach bridal blue to side seam of left underarm, ch 2 , work 12 hdc evenly sp along front armhole edge to shoulder seam, hdc in shoulder seam, 12 hdc evenly sp along back armhole edge to beg, join in beg ch-2, turn. ( 26 hdc )
Rnds 2-18: Rep rnds 2-17 of First Sleeve. (16 hdc)

## DUSTER BOTTOM

Row 1: With RS facing, attach bridal blue to left front bottom edge, ch 2, working along opposite side of foundation ch of Front and back Bodice as follows, hdc in each of next 11 chs to side seam, hdc in side seam, hdc in each of next 9 chs to center back seam, hdc in center back seam, hdc in each of next 9 chs, hdc in side seam, hdc in each of rem 12 chs, turn. ( 45 hdc )
Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.
Rows 3 \& 4: Rep row 2.
Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to approximately first side seam, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc to approximately center back seam, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc to approximately rem side seam, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each rem hdc across, turn. (48 hdc)
Rows 6-8: Rep row 2.
Rows 9-35: Rep rows 5-8, ending with row 7 at right front center edge. Do not fasten off.

## EDGING

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in side of last hdc of row 35, work fptr (see Special Stitch) around front lp of 3 rd hdc of row 34, sc in side of last hdc of row 33, [fptr around front lp of 3rd hdc in next even row, sc in side of last hdc of next odd row] rep to row 1 of Duster Bottom, sc in last beg ch of Bodice, sc in side of last hdc of row 1 of Bodice, [fptr around front lp of 3rd hdc in next even row, sc in side of last hdc of next odd row] rep to row 12 of Bodice, sl st in side of last hdc of row 11, ch 3 , work 28 dc around neck-
line, ending with last dc in row 13 of Left Front Bodice, ch 3, sl st in side of last hdc of row 12 , sc in side of last hdc of row 11, [fptr around front lp of 3rd hdc of next even row, sc in side of last hdc of next odd row] rep along left center front edge to bottom, ending sc in side of last hdc of row 35 , ch 1 , working along bottom edge, sc in top of first hdc of row 35 , [fptr around post of next hdc in row 34 , sc in next hdc of row 35 ] across, join in beg sc. Fasten off. ( 78 fptr sts )

## UPPER COLLAR

Row 1: Join bridal blue to top of beg ch-3 of Collar on edging row, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), working in back lps (see Stitch Guide), dc in each of next 28 dc , dc in top of ch-3. Fasten off. ( 30 dc )

## BELT

Row 1: Ch 45, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (44 sc)
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Fold Upper Collar to inside, sew top edge of Upper Collar to bottom edge of Collar.
Sew hook and eye to center front of Duster at waistline.
Sew Belt to waistline of Duster.
Beg at Waistline and working up each side of Bodice Front, sew 1 pearl bead at base of each of next 7 fptr sts.
